#### SOURCE AND CONTENT

The figures submitted herewith represent stocks of fruit and vegetables; fresh, frozen and in preservatives, held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in farm storages of commercial growers.

Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Department of Agriculture. Stocks of fruit and vegetables, frozen and in preservatives are obtained by mail questionnaire.

#### APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 6,531,000 bushels, compared with 6,191,000 bushels last year.

### PEARS

There were 336,000 bushels of Pears on hand on November 1, 1953.

## FRUIT FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 3,872,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 19,001,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 11,341,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 11,800,000 lb. and last month to 10,704,000 lb. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 34,214,000 lb as compared with 30,680,000 lb. last year and 33,542,000 lb. last month

#### VEGETABLES

Holdings of vegetables were:

- POTATO Stocks of potatoes were 27,466,000 bushels, as compared with 21,921,000 bushels last year.
- ONION Stocks of onions were reported as 1,243,000 bushels as compared with 1,010,000 bushels last year.
- CARROTS Stocks of carrots amounted to 1,216,000 bushels as compared with 1,048,000 bushels last year.
- CABBAGE Stocks of cabbages decreased to 368,000 bushels from 420,000 bushels last year.
- CELERY There were 273,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at November 1 there were 218,000 crates.

#### VEGETABLES FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers I lb. and Under" showed a total of 5,416,000 lb. while for "Over I lb." the total was IO,544,000 lb. There were 6,830,000 lb. held "In Brine".
