## FRUIT FROZEN AND IN PRESERVET IVES

There were $3,872,000 \mathrm{1b}$ ．of fruit in＂Containers 1 lb 。 and Under＂ While for＂Over 1 lb ＂the total was $19,001,0001 \mathrm{~b}$ ．

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $11,341,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．A year ago they amounted to $11,800,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ，and last monts to $10_{2}, 704,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．The total of all fruit，frozen and in preservatives was $34,214,000 \mathrm{lb}$ as compared with $30,680,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。1ast year and $33,542,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。 last montl：

CARROTS Stocks of carrots anomted to $1,216,000$ bushels as compared with $1,048,000$ bushels last year．

CABBAGE Stocks of cabbages decreased te 368,000 bushels from 420,000 bushela last year．

CELERT There were 273,000 crates of celery on hand．Last year at November 1 there were 218,000 crates．
