## STOCKS

FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

MAY 1953

Prepared in Live Stock Section, AGRICULTURE DIVISION

The figures submitted herewith represent stociks of fruit and vegetables; fresh, frozen and in preservatives, beld by food processors, cold storgges, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in farm storages of comercial growers.

Inventories of freah fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Department of Agriculture. Stocks of fruit and vegetables, frozen and in preservatives are obtained by mail questionnalre.


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## APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 325,000 bushels, compared with 267,000 bushels last year.

PEARS
There were 2,000 bushels of Pears on hand on May 1, 1953.

## FRUIT, FROZRN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 680,000 2b of fruit in "Containers $12 b$ and Under" wille for "aver 1 lb " " the total was 8,771,000 1 b .

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 9,684,000 1 b . A year ago they amounted to $12,040,000 \mathrm{lb}$ and last month to $10,935,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit. frozen and in preservatives was $19,135,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $26,393,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and 22,529,000 1b. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of vegetables were:
POTATO Stocks of potatoes were $4,499,000$ bushels, as compared with 4,067,000 bushels last year.

ONION Stocks of onions were reported as 104,000 bushels as compared with 58,000 bushels last year.

CARROTS Stocks of carrots amounted to 107,000 bushels as compared with 69,000 bushels last year.

CABBACR Stocks of cabbages increased to 27,000 bushels from 17,000 bushels last year.

CELMRY There were 17,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at May 1 there were 14,000 crates.

## VEGETABLESS, FROLEN NND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb . and Under" showed a total of $2,097,000 \mathrm{lb}$. while for "Over 1 lb " " the total was $4,491,000$ 1b. There were $4,129,000$ lb. held "In Exine。"
