## SOURCE AND CONTENT

The ifgures submitted herewith represent stocks of fruit and vegetables; fresh, frozen and in preservatives, held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in larm storages of commercial growers.

Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Department of Agriculture. Stocke of fruit and vegetables, frozen and in preservatives are obtained by mail questionnaire.

## APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 137,000 bushels, compared with 96,000 bushels last year.

PEARS
There were 1,000 bushels of Pears on hand on June $1,1953$. FRUIT, FROTEN AND IN PRESERVAIIVES

There were $448,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of Iruit in "Containers 1 lbo and Under" while for "Over 1 lb。" the total was 6,930,000 1 bo

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $8,289,000 \mathrm{lb}$. A year ago they amounted to $10,145,000 \mathrm{lb}$ and last month to $9,580,000$ 1b. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was $15,667,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $22,517,000$ lb. last year and $19,115,000$ last month.

## VEGETABLES

Holdings of regetables were:
POTATO Stocks of potatoes were $1,957,000$ bushels, as compared with 727,000 bushels last year.

ONION Stocks of onions were reported as 86,000 bashels: as compared with 53,000 bushels last year.

CARROTS Stocks of carrots amounted to 64,000 bushels as compared with 51,000 bushels last year.

CABBACR Stocks of cabbages increased to 24,000 bushels from 21,000 bushels last year.

CELPRY There were 10,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at June 1 there were 11,000 crates.
