APPLES Canadian apples held in cold and cormon storage were 7，581，000 bushels，compared with $6,531,000$ bushels last year．

FEARS There were 231，000 bushels of Peara on hand on November 1，1954．

## FRUIT，FROZEN AND IN FRESERVATIVES

There were $5,239,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。of fruit in＂Containers 1 lb 。 and Under＂while for＂Over 1 lb ＂the total was $22,082,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $12,259,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．A year ago they amounted to $11,391,000 \mathrm{lb}$ and last month to $10,663,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．The total of all fruit，frozen and in preservatives was $39,580,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．as compared with $34,101,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．last year and $37,260,000$ 1b．last month．

VEGETABTES Holdings of vegetables were：
Stocks of potaioes were 22，921，000 bushels，as compared with $27,468,000$ bushels last year．Stocks of onions were reported as 661，000 bushels as compared with $1,243,000$ bushels last year．Stocks of carrots amounted to 564,000 bushels as compared with $1,215,000$ bushels last year． Stocks of cabbages increased to 559,000 bushels from 368,000 bushels last year．There wore 184,000 crates of celery on hand．Last year at November 1， there were 273,000 crates．

## VEGETABLES，FROZEN AND IN BRINE

＂Containers 1 lb ，and Under＂showed a total of 7，317，000 1b。 while for＂Over 1 lb ．＂the total was $10,757,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．There were $5,529,000$ lb．held＂In Brine．＂
