STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

<u>APPLES</u> Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 1,867,000 bushels, compared with 2,012,000 bushels last year.

PEARS There were 32,000 bushels of Pears on hand on March 1, 1954.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 3,561,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 14,925,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 11,387,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 12,160,000 lb. and last month to 11,922,000 lb. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 29,873,000 lb. as compared with 25,060,000 lb. last year and 32,122,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES Holdings of vegetables were:

<u>POTATOES</u> Stocks of potatoes were 12,947,000 bushels, as compared with 12,247,000 bushels last year.

<u>ONIONS</u> Stocks of onions were reported as 461,000 bushels as compared with 230,000 bushels last year.

<u>CARROTS</u> Stocks of carrots amounted to 242,000 bushels as compared with 230,000 bushels last year.

CABBAGE Stocks of cabbages decreased to 65,000 bushels from 77,000 bushels last year.

CELERY There were 19,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at March 1 there were 13,000 crates.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 1b. and Under" showed a total of 4,388,000 lb. while for "Over 1 1b." the total was 9,753,000 lb. There were 4,714,000 lb. held "In Brine."
