## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 3,497,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 la mandoTHEQUE Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 12,173,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 8,399,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 8,189,000 lb. and last month to 8,856,000 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 24,069,000 lb. as compared with 22,609,000 lb. last year and 23,260,000 lb. last month.

## VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 1b. and Under" showed a total of 4,134,000 1b. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 4,557,000 lb. There were 3,833,000 lb. held "In Brine."
