## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEG3TABLES

APPLES Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 561，000 hushols，compared with 577,000 bushels last year．

PEARS There were 13,000 bushels of Pears on hand on Hay 1， 1957

## FRUTT，FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were $2,850,000 \mathrm{lb}$ of fruit in＂Containers 1 lb 。 and Under＂while for＂Over $1 \mathrm{lb} \mathrm{b}^{\prime \prime}$ the total was $12,589,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。

The stocks of fruit in sulphur diokide or in benzoate of soda totalled $10,214,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．A year ago they amounted to $10,825,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．and last month $10,770,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．The total of all fruit，frozen and in preserv－ atives was $25,653,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。as compared with $27,611,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。last year and $28,820,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。lest month。

VEGELAHLSS Holdings of vegetables were：
Stocks of potatoes were $3,858,000$ hundredweight as compared with 3，285，000 hundredweight last year．Stocks of onions were reported as 63，000 bushels as compared with 69,000 bushols last year．stocks of carrots amounted to 102,000 bushels as compared with 103,000 bushels last year．Stocks of cabbage decreased to 28,000 bushels from 33,000 bushels last year．There were 22,000 crates of celery on hand．Last year at kiay 1 there were 21,000 crates．

## VEGETABLFSS，FROZFN AND IN BRINE

＂Containers 1 1b。 and Under＂showed a total of 11，291，000 1b． while for＂Over 1 lb 。＂the total was 9，797，000 lb ．There were 2，194，000 lb．held＂In Brine。＂
