## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 8,322,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 26,081,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 10,612,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 10,712,000 lb. and last month to 9,104,000 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 45,015,000 lb. as compared with 50,521,000 lb. last year and 44,820,000 lb. last month.

## VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 13,653,000 lb. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 36,604,000 lb. There were 8,713,000 lb. held "In Brine".
