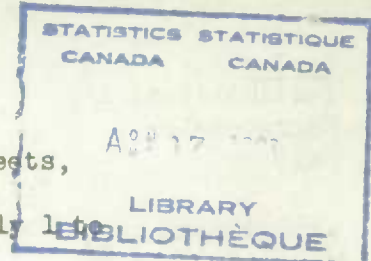

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

Stocks of apples, pears, potatoes, onions, celery, beets, carrots and parsnips will not be reported for the period July 1 to October 1 inclusive.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 7,563,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 28,236,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 9,067,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 8,338,000 lb. and last month to 8,523,000 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 44,866,000 lb. as compared with 49,408,000 lb. last year and 41,649,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 11,243,000 lb. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 28,107,000 lb. There were 2,951,000 lb. held "In Brine".
