STOCKS of FPUIT and VEGETABLES

Stocks of apples, pears, potatoes, onfons, celery, beets, carrots and parsnips will not be reported for the period July 1 to October 1 inclusive.

## FRUIT, FROZEN and IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 7,255,000 1b. of fruit in Containers 1 1b and Under" while for "Over I Ib." the total was 25,750,000 1b.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or benzoate of soda totailed a,452,000 1 b . A year ago they amounted to $10,445,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to 8,481,000 lb .

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was $41,457,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $45,222,000 \mathrm{Ib}$. Last year and 45,749,000 1b. last month.

VEGFTABLES, FROZFN and IN BRINE
"Containers 1 1b. and Under" showed a total of 11,736,000 1b. While for "Over 1 1b," the total was $38,548,0001 \mathrm{lb}$. There were $6,696,000$ 1b. held "In Brine".
