Stocks of apples, pears, potatoes, onions, celery, carrots and cabbage will not be reported for the period July to October inclusive.

## FRUIT, FTLUEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES:

There were 3,997,000 lb of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . and Under" while for "Over 1 lb .0 the total was $16,909,000 \mathrm{lb}$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $8,044,000 \mathrm{lb}$. A year ago they amounted to $7,958,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to $7,507,000 \mathrm{lb}$.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was $28,950,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $32,460,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $26,635,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

## VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE:

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to $34,897,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $29,298,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. There were $3,132,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of vegetables held in brine as against $4,671,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。 last year.
