

APPLES: Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were $9,114,000$ bushels, compared with $10,173,000$ bushels last year.

PEARS: There were 192,000 bushels of pears on hand on December $1,1964$.

## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES:

There were $8,856,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . and Under" as against $35,381,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. in "Containers Over 1 lb .1

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $13,233,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. A year ago they amounted to $12,019,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month $11,333,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was $57,470,000$ 1 b. as compared with $49,727,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. last year and $56,500,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

VEGETABLES: Stocks of potatoes were $19,958,000$ hundredweight, as compared with $21,448,000$ hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as $1,652,000$ bushels as compared with $1,885,000$ bushels last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to $1,488,000$ bushels as compared with $1,530,000$ bushels last year. Stocks of cabbage decreased to 182,000 bushels from 209,000 bushels last year. There were 45,000 crates of celery on hand at December 1,1964 , as compared with 46,000 crates last year.

## VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE:

The total stocks of frozen vegetabies amounted to $85,268,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $72,167,0001 \mathrm{l}$. last year. There were $8,051,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. of vegetables held in brine as against 7,320,000 lb. last year.

## NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represent stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives), held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of commercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canada Department of Agriculture.
