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STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES APPLES: Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 12,418,000 bushels. compared with 11,785,000 bushels last year.

PEARS: There were 637,000 bushels of pears on hand at November 1, 1966.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES:

There were 9,546,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" as against 41,277,000 lb. in "Containers Over 1 lb.".

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 10,829,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 11,083,000 lb. and last month 10,546,000 lb. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was 61,652,000 1b. as compared with 52,935,000 1b. last year and 64,082,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES: Stocks of potatoes were 32,360,000 hundredweight, as compared with 24,733,000 hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as 2,160,000 bushels as compared with 2,469,000 bushels last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to 1,960,000 bushels as compared with 1,333,000 bushels last year. Stocks of cabbage increased to 166,000 bushels from 124,000 bushels last year. There were 54,000 crates of celery on hand at November 1, 1966, as compared with 72,000 crates last year.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE:

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to 84,021,000 lb. as compared with 89,676,000 lb. last year. There were 13,628,000 lb. of vegetables held in brine as against 8,101,000 lb. last year.

NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represent stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives), held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of commercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canada Department of Agriculture.
