STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

APPLES: Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 10,196,000 bushels, compared with 9,722,000 bushels last year.

PEARS: There were 314,000 bushels of pears on hand at December 1, 1966.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES:

There were 9,067,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers I lb. and Under". as against 39,589,000 lb. in "Containers Over I lb.".

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 12,055,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 12,269,000 lb. and last month 10,569,000 lb. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was 60,711,000 it. as compared with 51,915,000 lb. last year and 61,689,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES: Stocks of potatoes were 28,496,000 hundredweight, as compared with 22,378,000 hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as 1,448,000 bushels as compared with 2,382,000 bushels last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to 1,654,000 bushels as compared with 1,304,000 bushels last year. Stocks of cabbage decreased to 158,000 bushels from 162,000 bushels last year. There were 31,000 crates of celery on hand at December 1, 1966, as compared with 40,000 crates last year.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE:

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to 79,259,000 lb. as compared with 83,996,000 lb. last year. There were 13,317,000 lb. of vegetables held in brine as against 7,230,000 lb. last year.

NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represent stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives), held by food processors, cold storages, fruite warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of commercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canada Department of Agriculture.
