## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

APPLES: Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were $12,584,000$ bushels compared with $12,320,000$ bushels last year.

PEARS: There were 387,000 bushels of pears on hand at November $1,1967$.

## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES:

There were $9,148,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of fruit in "Containers l lb . and Under", as against $35,672,000 \mathrm{lb}$. in "Containers Over $1 \mathrm{lb} . "$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc. totalled 8,887,000 1b. A year ago they amounted to $11,990,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month $9,648,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all Eruit frozen and in preservatives was $53,707,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $63,573,000$ 10. last year and $58,341,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

VEGETABLES: Stocks of potatoes were $27,269,000$ hundredweight, as compared with 36,043,000 hundredweight last year. Stocks of onfons were reported as $1,803,000$ bushels as compared with $2,160,000$ bushels last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to $1,560,000$ bushels as compared with $1,960,000$ bushels last year. Stocks of cabbage decreased to 156,000 bushels from 166,000 bushels last year. The inspection services of the Canada Department of Agriculture ceased to collect monthly inventories of celery as of November 1, 1967.

## VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE:

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to $79,076,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $86,437,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended for re-manufacture amounted to $9,401,000 \mathrm{lb}$. There were $15,499,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of vegetables held in brine as against $14,082,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year.

## NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represent stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives) held by food processors, cold storages, fruft warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of commercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canadian Department of Agriculture.
