## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

APPLES: Canadian applies held in cold and common storage/were $10,892,000$ bushels compared with $10,186,000$ bushels last year.

PEARS: There were 141,000 bushels of pears on hand at December 1, 1967.

## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN RRESERVATIVES:

There were $8,561,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . and Under", as against $35,148,000 \mathrm{lb}$. in "Containers Over $1 \mathrm{lb} . "$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc. totalled 9,334,000 1 b . A year ago they amounted to $13,473,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month $9,015,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was $53,043,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with 62,779,000 lb. last year and $54,266,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

VEGETABLES: Stocks of potatoes were $23,256,000$ hundredweight, as compared with $31,496,000$ hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as $1,572,000$ bushels as compared with $1,426,000$ bushels last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to $1,077,000$ bushels as compared with $1,650,000$ bushels last year. Stocks of cabbage decreased to 118,000 bushels from 141,000 bushels last year. The inspection services of the Canads Department of Agriculture ceased to collect monthly inventories of celery as of November 1, 1967.

## VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE:

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to $81,090,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $78,079,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended for re-manufacture amounted to $9,669,000 \mathrm{lb}$. There were $14,167,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of vegetables held in brine as against 13,317,000 1b. last year.

## NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represent stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives) held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of commercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canadian Department of Agriculture.
