

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

SEPTEMBER 1968

Stocks of apples, pears, potatoes, onions, carrots and cabbage will not be reported for the period July to October inclusive.

Fruit, frozen and in preservatives

There were 8,914,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" as against 35,684,000 lb. in "Containers over 1 lb.".

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc., totalled 6,002,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 9,954,000 lb. and last month to 6,385,000 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 50,600,000 lb. as compared with 60,495,000 lb. last year and 47,437,000 lb. last month.

Vegetables, frozen and in brine

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to 74,289,000 lb. as compared with 69,685,000 lb. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended to re-manufacture amounted to 6,122,000 lb. There were 9,541,000 lb. of vegetables held in brine as against 12,631,000 lb. last year.
