STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

November 1969

Apples. - Canadianyapples held in cold and common storage were 538,474,000 lb. compared with 483,669,000 lbE lest year.

Pears. - There were 15,778,000 lb. of pears on hand at November 1, 1969.

Fruit, frozen and in preservatives. — There were 7,867,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under", as against 46,197,000 lb. in "Containers over 1 lb."

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc. totalled 6,696,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 6,114,000 lb. and last month 6,341,000 lb. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was 60,760,000 lb. as compared with 46,936,000 lb. last year and 62,658,000 lb. last month.

Vegetables. — Stocks of potatoes were 28,922,000 hundredweight, as compared with 32,785,000 hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as 117,710,000 lb. as compared with 151,050,000 lb. last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to 151,284,000 lb. as compared with 116,850,000 lb. last year. Stocks of cabbage increased to 16,264,000 lb. from 8,505,000 lb. last year.

Vegetables, frozen and in brine. — The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to 99,249,000 lb. as compared with 99,742,000 lb. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended for re-manufacture amounted to 13,451,000 lb. There were 17,072,000 lb. of vegetables held in brine as against 11,626,000 lb. last year.

NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represents stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives) held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of commercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained throught the inspection services of the Canadian Department of Agriculture.
