## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

JULY 1, 1971

Stocks of apples, pears, potatoes, onions, carrots and cabbage will not be reported for the period July to October inclusive.

## Fruit, Frozen and in preservatives

There were $2,728,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of fruit in "Containers l lb . and Under" as against $21,418,000 \mathrm{lb}$. in "Containers over $1 \mathrm{lb} . "$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc., totalled $6,196,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. A year ago they amounted to $5,991,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to $6,730,000 \mathrm{lb}$.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was $30,342,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $45,000,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. last year and $31,371,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. last month.

Vegetables, frozen and in brine

The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to $50,509,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $49,099,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended for re-manufacture amounted to $8,782,000 \mathrm{lb}$. There were $5,961,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of vegetables held in brine as against $6,774,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year.
