## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

December 1, 1972
Apples. - Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were $414,868,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. compared with $447,380,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. 1ast year.

Pears. - There were $11,265,000 \mathrm{1b}$. of pears on hand at December 1, 1972 .
Fruit, frozen and in preservatives. - There were $4,635,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . and Mnder", as against 34,707,000 lb . in "Containers over 1 lb .".

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc. totalled 8,889,000 $\mathbf{l b}$. A year ago they amounE0A ts $7,691,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month $7,056,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was $48,231,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $52,741,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $50,002,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

Vegetables. - Stocks of potatoes were $23,260,000$ hundredweight, as compared with $30,182,000$ hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as $76,676,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. as compared with $103,810,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to $106,711,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $98,698,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Stocks of cabbage increased to $11,431,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. from $10,650,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year.

Vegetables, frozen and in brime. - The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to $98,104,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $96,138,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended for re-manufacture amounted to $9,093,000 \mathrm{lb}$. There were $8,602,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of vegetables held in brine as against $9,685,000 \mathrm{lb}$. 1ast year.

## NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represents stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives) held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of comercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canadian Department of Agriculture.
