## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

MAY 1, 1973

Apples. - Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were $58,375,000 \mathrm{lb}$. compared with $80,530,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. last year.

Pears. - There were $2,138,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of pears on hand at May 1, 1973.
Fruit, frozen and in preservatives. - There were $1,878,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . min Inder", as against $22,330,000 \mathrm{lb}$. in "Containers over $1 \mathrm{lb} . "$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide, etc. totalled 8,007,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to $8,959,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month $8,588,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit frozen and in preservatives was 3?,215,000 lb . as compared with $37,054,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $34,923,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

Vegetables. - Stocks of potatoes were $6,043,000$ hundredweight, as compared with $11,052,000$ hundredweight last year. Stocks of onions were reported as $3,453,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $17,159,000$ lb. last year. Stocks of carrots amounted to $14,908,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $6,912,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Stocks of cabbage increased to $1,538,000 \mathrm{lb}$. from $1,512,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year.

Vegetables, frozen and in brine. - The total stocks of frozen vegetables amounted to 42,485,000 1 lb . as compared with $48,792,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. Current holdings of frozen vegetables intended for remanufacture amounted to $4,816,000 \mathrm{lb}$. There were $3,631,000 \mathrm{lb}$. of vegetables held in brine as against 5,181,000 lb . last year.

## NOTE AS TO SOURCE AND CONTENT

The data contained in this report represents stocks of fruit and vegetables (fresh, frozen and in preservatives) held by food processors, cold storages, fruit warehouses, wholesalers and in storages of growers in certain areas of comercial production. Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Canadian Department of Agriculture.
