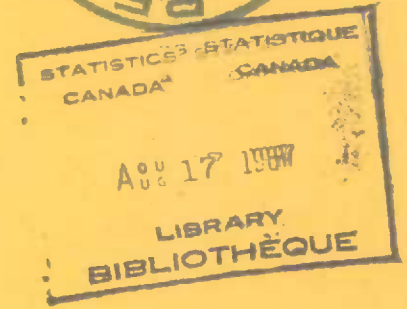

STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND
(Including Honey)

JANUARY, 1950

The Dominion Bureau presents their report on the Stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses at January, 1950. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2 - 8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9 - 15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16 - 22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1948, up to the January 1, 1950 quarter.

The inventory of canned fruits increased considerably in this quarter to 5,971,867 dozen containers from 4,745,629 dozen containers at October 1st last and more than 1,800,000 dozen containers more than January 1st, 1949. The holdings of peaches, pears and pineapple showed major increases of 954,365 dozen containers, 568,247 dozen containers and 152,945 dozen containers respectively, over the quarter, January 1st, 1949. Increases prevailed in all apple products except Solid Pack apples compared to one year ago. Plums with 372,947 dozen containers and cherries 338,926 dozen containers were the only major decreases in this period.

Canned vegetable stocks decreased slightly to 20,799,960 dozen containers at January 1st, 1950 from 21,881,841 dozen containers at October 1st, 1949. The holdings of corn, tomatoes, and carrots and peas provided major increases of approximately 4,100,000 dozen containers, 560,000 dozen containers and 245,000 dozen containers respectively compared to holdings at January 1, 1949. While the over-all inventory showed an increase of approximately 2,300,000 dozen containers compared to January 1st, 1949, major decreases were reported in dozen containers as follows: Peas, 2,147,000; green-beans 505,000; baked beans, 123,000; and pumpkin 184,000.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6, 7 of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2, and 3.
