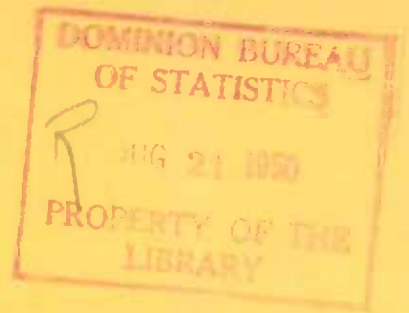

STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND

(Including Honey)

JULY 1, 1950)

The Dominion Bureau presents their report on the Stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses at July 1, 1950. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9 - 15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16 - 22 and D- Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1948, up to the July 1, 1950 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures have been made in this report. The revisions were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned Fruits inventories decreased to 2,823,789 dozen containers at July 1, 1950 from 4,805,429 dozen containers held at April 1, 1950. There were approximately 1,000,000 dozen containers more than were reported one year previously at July 1, 1949, when 1,767,626 dozens were reported. The fruits participating in this increased inventory are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Peaches, 524,904; Pears, 393,852; Pineapple, 62,193; Applesauce, 155,921; Fruits for salads, 66,977 and Raspberries, 69,707. Major decreases in Fruits held, compared to July 1, 1949, were, Plums and Gages, 208,691 dozen containers, Cherries, 27,765 dozen containers and strawberries, 74,546 dozen containers.

Canned Vegetables inventories decreased nearly 4,300,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On April 1, 1950, 16,582,702 dozens were reported compared to the July 1, 1950 figure of 12,290,963 dozens which holdings were still 1,000,000 dozens higher than were reported one year ago when 11,298,080 dozen containers were reported on July 1, 1949. Major increases in holdings, compared to the same quarter last year, appear respectively in dozens of containers as follows: Corn, 3,618,920; Baked Beans, 438,485; Macedoine, 123,244; Beets, 106,242 and Asparagus, 104,758. In the same period Peas had decreased 2,364,518 dozen; Green Beans by 567,895 dozen; Tomatoes by 388,650 dozen as well as Pumpkin, which had decreased by 166,942 dozen containers.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6, 7, of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2, and 3.
