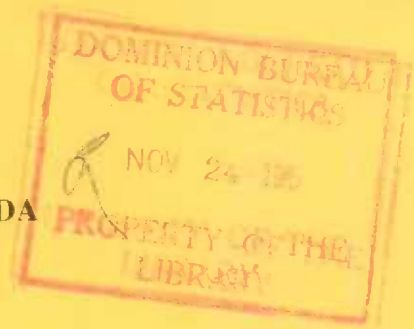

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STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND  
(Including Honey)  
OCTOBER 1, 1950

The Dominion Bureau presents their report on the stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses, October 1, 1950. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9-15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16-22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1948, up to the October 1, 1950 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures have been made in this report. The revisions were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned Fruits inventories increased to 4,361,126 dozen containers at October 1, 1950 from 2,823,789 dozen containers held at July 1, 1950. There were approximately 400,000 dozen containers less than were reported one year previously at October 1, 1949, when 4,745,629 dozens were reported. The fruits whose inventory showed major increases compared to October 1, 1949 are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Apricots, 153,584; Apple Products, 139,630; Pineapple, 132,592; Pears, 129,623 and Plums and Gages, 98,572. The decrease in Peaches held, compared to one year ago, was mainly responsible for the decrease in the total inventory of fruits on hand. The major decreases were: Peaches, 816,080 and Raspberries, 111,468 dozens, respectively.

Canned Vegetables inventories increased nearly 7,000,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On July 1, 1950, 12,290,963 dozens were reported compared to the October 1, 1950 figure of 19,218,297 dozens which holdings were about 2,600,000 dozens less than were reported one year ago when 21,881,841 dozen containers were reported on October 1, 1949. Major increases in holdings, compared to the same quarter last year, appear respectively in dozens of containers as follows: Beets, 412,887; Baked Beans, 312,738 and Asparagus, 151,797. In the same period Tomatoes had decreased 1,857,124 dozen; Peas by 1,025,473 dozen; Corn by 620,170 dozen and as well Green Beans decreased by 161,301 dozen containers.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6, 7, of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2 and 3.
