STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND

(Including Honey)

January 1, 1951

The Dominion Bureau presents their report on the stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses, January 1, 1951. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9-15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16-22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1948, up to the January 1, 1951 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures have been made in this report. The revisions were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned Fruits inventories increased to 5,877,642 dozen containers at January 1, 1951 from 4,361,126 dozen containers held at October 1, 1950. There were approximately 140,000 dozen containers less than were reported one year previously at January 1, 1950, when 5,020,572 dozens were reported. The fruits whose inventory showed major increases compared to January 1, 1950 are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Apricots, 117,115; Pears, 338,056 and Plums and Gages, 111,969. The decrease in Peaches held, compared to one year ago, was mainly responsible for the decrease in the total inventory of fruits on hand. The major decreases were: Peaches, 514,167, Raspberries, 116,471 dozens and cherries, 102,974 dozens, respectively.

Canned Vegetables inventories decreased nearly 2,000,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On October 1, 1950, 19,218,297 dozens were reported compared to the January 1, 1951 figure of 17,488,693 dozens which holdings were about 4,000,000 dozens less than were reported one year ago when 21,314,806 dozen containers were reported on January 1, 1950. Major increases in holdings, compared to the same quarter last year, appear respectively in dozens of containers as follows: Beets, 355,261; Baked Beans, 155,886; Asparagus, 136,512; Macedoine, 156,288. In addition the holdings of Carrots, Carrots and Peas combined and spinach increased approximately 100,000 dozens in the same period. In the same period Tomatoes had decreased 2,615,755 dozen; Peas by 1,640,694 dozen; Corn by 602,902 dozen and as well Green Beans decreased by 132,631 dozen containers.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6, 7, of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2 and 3.
