STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND

(Including Honey)

April 1, 1951

The Dominion Bureau presents its report on the stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses, April 1, 1951. The report is now sectionalized into; A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9-15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16-22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1949, up to the January 1, 1951 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned Fruits inventories decreased to 5,002,649 dozen containers at April 1, 1951 from 5,872,642 dozen containers held at January 1, 1951. There were approximately 200,000 dozen containers more than were reported one year previously at April 1, 1950, when 4,805,429 dozens were reported. The fruits whose inventory showed major increases compared to April 1, 1950 are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Pears, 313,479; Fruits for Salad, 209,824; Apples and Apple Products, 143,726 and Plums and Gages, 112,818. The major decreases compared to one year ago, were; Peaches, 440,407 and Raspberries, 98,373 dozens, respectively.

Canned Vegetables inventories decreased nearly 5,500,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On January 1, 1950, 17,488,693 dozens were reported compared to the April 1, 1951 figure of 11,773,540 dozens which holdings were about 5,000,000 dozens less than were reported one year ago when 16,582,702 dozen containers were reported on April 1, 1950. Major increases in holdings, compared to the same quarter last year, appear respectively in dozens of containers as follows: Baked Beans, 358,326; Beets, 330,133; Carrots, 121,217; Carrots and Peas, 114,908; Asparagus, 106,913 and Macedoine, 105,569. In the same period Tomatoes had decreased 2,814,498 dozen; Peas by 1,836,912 dozen; Corn by 1,235,340 dozen.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6, 7, of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2 and 3.
