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STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND

(Including Honey)

July 1, 1951

The Dominion Bureau presents its report on the stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses, July 1, 1951. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9-15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16-22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1949, up to the July 1, 1951 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned Fruits inventories decreased to 3,525,319 dozen containers at July 1, 1951 from 5,002,649 containers held at April 1, 1951. There were approximately 700,000 dozen containers more than were reported one year previously at July 1, 1950, when 2,823,789 dozens were reported. The fruits whose inventory showed major increases compared with July 1, 1950 are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Pears, 339,185; Applesauce, 142,054; Plums and Gages, 128,418; Fruits for Salad, 120,981 and Strawberries, 117,909. The major decrease compared with one year ago appeared in Peaches with 188,425 dozen containers.

Canned Vegetables inventories decreased approximately 4,000,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On April 1, 1951, 11,773,540 dozens were reported compared with the July 1, 1951 figure of 7,731,860 dozens which holdings were about 4,500,000 dozens less than were reported one year ago when 12,290,963 dozen containers were reported on July 1, 1950. Major increases in holdings, compared with the same quarter last year, appear, respectively, in dozens of containers as follows: Baked Beans, 323,616; Beets, 279,067; Carrots, 161,148 and Spinach, 133,398. In the same period Tomatoes had decreased 2,345,501 dozen; Corn by 1,926,724 dozen; Peas by 1,305,700 dozen.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6 and 7 of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2 and 3.
