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STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND
(Including Honey)

October 1, 1951

The Dominion Bureau presents its report on the stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses, Oct. 1, 1951. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9-15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16-22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1949, up to the October 1, 1951 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned fruits inventories increased to 7,172,093 dozen containers at October 1, 1951 from 3,525,319 containers held at July 1, 1951. There were approximately 2,800,000 dozen containers more than were reported one year previously at October 1, 1950, when 4,361,126 dozens were reported. The fruits whose inventory showed major increases compared with October 1, 1950 are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Peaches, 1,172,122; Pears, 553,928; Applesauce, 231,568; Cherries, 206,105; Fruits for Salad, 128,732 and Raspberries, 116,190.

Canned Vegetables inventories increased approximately 13,000,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On July 1, 1951, 7,731,860 dozens were reported compared with the October 1, 1951 figure of 20,212,533 dozens which holdings were about 1,000,000 dozens more than were reported one year ago when 19,218,297 dozen containers were reported on October 1, 1950. Major increases in holdings, compared with the same quarter last year, appear, respectively, in dozens of containers as follows: Peas, 1,440,446; Green Beans, 689,807; Beets, 419,834; Spinach, 161,924 and Carrots, 116,314. In the same period Tomatoes had decreased 1,067,140 dozen; and Corn by 1,076,238 dozen.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6 and 7 of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2 and 3.
