STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND  
(Including Honey)

January 1, 1952

The Dominion Bureau presents its report on the stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses, January 1, 1952. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2-8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9-15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16-22 and D - Honey, page 25. Beginning this quarter, Inventories of Vinegar, Mayonnaise, Sandwich Spread, Peanut Butter and Prepared Mustard are included on pages 23-24.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for 1950, up to January 1, 1952 quarter. In addition, slight revisions in January 1, 1950 figures were necessitated by incorrect reporting in this specific quarter.

Canned fruits inventories increased to 8,252,316 dozen containers at January 1, 1952 from 7,172,093 containers held at October 1, 1951. There were approximately 2,500,000 dozen containers more than were reported one year previously at January 1, 1951, when 5,877,642 dozens were reported. The fruits whose inventory showed major increases compared with January 1, 1951 are reported in dozens of containers as follows: Peaches, 1,137,555; Pears, 317,538; Cherries, 211,041; Plums and Gages, 157,674 and Raspberries, 106,774.

Canned Vegetables inventories decreased approximately 3,000,000 dozen containers in the last quarter. On October 1, 1951, 20,212,533 dozens were reported compared with the January 1, 1952 figure of 17,272,414 dozens which holdings were about 200,000 dozens less than were reported one year ago when 17,488,693 dozen containers were reported on January 1, 1951. Major increases in holdings, compared with the same quarter last year, appear, respectively, in dozens of containers as follows: Peas, 1,530,677; Green Beans, 562,240; Beets, 417,602; and Spinach, 101,775. In the same period Tomatoes had decreased 977,313 dozen; Corn by 1,613,121 dozen; Baked Beans by 192,237 dozen, and Mixed Vegetables by 161,700 dozen.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6 and 7 of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2 and 3.
