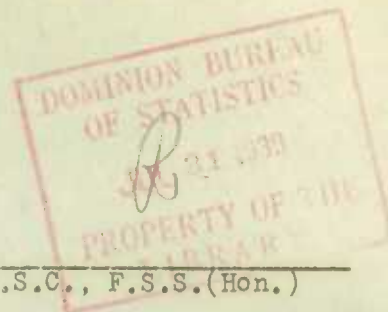

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON THE STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLESON HAND, JULY 1st, 1939.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics presents herewith a preliminary report on the stocks of canned fruits and vegetables on hand on July 1st, 1939. The statistics in the table below include the stocks held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses. A more detailed and final report will be published later when all returns are in. Firms not yet reporting for July had about 125,000 cases of canned fruits and vegetables on hand on April 1st, 1939. These firms will be included in the final report.
