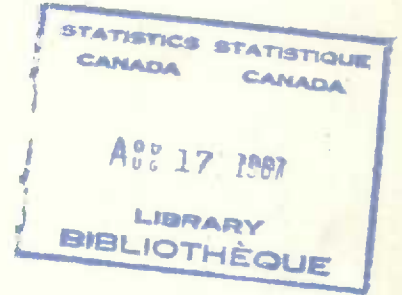


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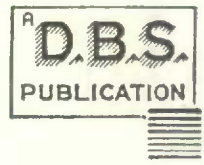

STOCKS OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES ON HAND
(Including Honey)

OCTOBER, 1949

The Dominion Bureau presents their report on the Stocks of Canned Fruits and Vegetables held by canners, wholesale dealers and chain store warehouses at October, 1949. The report is now sectionalized into: A - Canned Fruits, pages 2 - 8; B - Canned Vegetables, pages 9 - 15; C - Other Canned Products, pages 16 - 22 and D - Honey, page 23.

Table 1, in each division, presents quarterly data over a two-year period, ending always with the current quarter. In the present report figures are included for two quarters of 1947 to the October 1st quarter of 1949.

The inventory of canned fruits increased considerably in this quarter to 4,745,629 dozen containers from 1,767,626 dozen containers at July 1st and more than 1,200,000 dozen containers more than October 1st, 1948. The holdings of peaches, raspberries and pineapple showed major increases of 1,356,250 dozen containers, 161,512 dozen containers and 103,415 dozen containers respectively, over the quarter, October 1st 1948. Major decreases prevailed in all apple products compared to one year ago and in addition plums were down 210,032 dozen containers, pears 94,695 dozen containers and cherries 47,540 dozen containers in the same period.

Canned vegetable stocks increased to 21,751,951 dozen containers at October 1st, 1949 from 11,298,080 dozen containers at July 1st 1949. The holdings of corn, carrots and peas and tomatoes provided major increases of approximately 3,700,000 dozen containers, 570,000 dozen containers and 454,000 dozen containers respectively compared to holdings at October 1st, 1948. While the over-all inventory showed an increase of more than 2,000,000 dozen containers compared to October 1st, 1948, major decreases were reported in dozen containers as follows: Peas, 1,520,685; green-beans 409,590; baked beans, 233,765; beets, 196,850 and pumpkin, 124,639.

It may be noted that the reporting firms are required to show only the number of dozens of cans or other containers, specified according to sizes. This is done to expedite reporting and the conversion of the different sizes to net weight of contents is carried out in the Bureau. See Tables 5, 6, 7 of each respective section for the weights of products reported in Tables 1, 2, and 3.
