COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, OCTOBER 1, 1936.

The report issued to-day covers stocks of meat, poultry and fish products in Canada, by provinces and principal cities on October 1, 1936, with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at October 1, 1936 amounted to 28,154,854 pounds, of which 4,092,070 pounds were fresh not frozen, 7,675,497 pounds fresh frozen and 16,387,287 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings of firms that failed to report are estimated at 9,580 pounds, making a grand total of 28,164,434 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of approximately 3 million pounds or 40.3 per cent over those reported at October 1 of the previous year, and an increase of about 384 thousand pounds or 1.4 per cent as compared with the stocks reported at the first of the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at October 1, 1936 amounted to 2,185,395 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of 3,796 pounds for firms that failed to report, a grand total of 2,189,191 pounds is shown, which is approximately 883 thousand pounds or 28.7 per cent less than was reported at October 1, 1935 and approximately 100 thousand pounds or 4.4 per cent less than the quantity shown by firms reporting at the first of the previous month.

Total beef stocks, as reported, amounted to 16,483,473 pounds, 9,102,652 pounds being frozen, 6,652,175 pounds fresh not frozen, 302,242 pounds cured beef and 426,404 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 15,266 pounds, a grand total of 16,498,739 pounds is shown at October 1, 1936, an increase of approximately 4.2 million pounds or 34.1 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of the same month of 1935 and an increase of 3.7 million pounds or 29.8 per cent over the stocks reported at September 1, 1936.

Holdings of veal were reported at 4,590,374 pounds, 3,593,530 being fresh frozen and 996,844 pounds not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 1,033 pounds amounted to 4,591,407 pounds, an increase of 2 million pounds or 79.6 per cent compared with the quantity reported at October 1, 1935 and approximately 798 thousand pounds or 20.4 per cent over the quantity reported at the first of the previous month. The reported holdings of all stocks of mutton and lamb amounted to 1,763,585 pounds; 1,270,081 pounds of which were fresh frozen stocks and 493,504 fresh not frozen. With an estimate of 785 pounds to cover the holdings of firms which failed to report, a grand total of 1,764,370 pounds is shown. This represents an increase of almost 234 thousand pounds or 15.2 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of October, 1935, and an increase of 1 million pounds above the quantity reported at the first of September of this year.

Poultry stocks, as reported, amounted to 3,920,578 pounds. After adding 8,706 pounds for firms which failed to report it shows a grand total of 3,929,284 pounds, which represents an increase of nearly 2 million pounds or 98.1 per cent over the quantity reported at the first of the same month of the previous year and an increase of 235 thousand pounds or 6.4 per cent as compared with the stocks reported at the first of the previous month.

Fresh and frozen fish reported at October 1, 1936 amounted to 24,591,918 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 22,172 pounds making a grand total of 24,614,090 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at October 1 of the previous year, it shows an increase of approximately  $1\frac{1}{2}$  million pounds or 6.6 per cent and compared with the holdings at the first of the previous month, an increase of approximately 1 million pounds or 4.4 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish were reported at October 1, 1936 as 6,318,552 pounds which, combined with an estimate of 3,349 pounds, makes a grand total of 6,321,901 pounds. Making comparisons with stocks reported at October 1, 1935 these stocks represent an increase of 867 thousand pounds or 15.9 per cent, and compared with the holdings reported at September 1 of this year, an increase of approximately 286 thousand pounds or 4.3 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of September amounted to 3,700,553 pounds, representing a decrease of nearly a half million pounds or 9.9 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of September 1935, and a decrease of 2.3 million pounds or 38.6 per cent in comparison with the quantities frozen during the month of August 1936.

The estimated stocks represent the holdings of 14 firms which failed to send in their statements in time for the figures to be included in this report.
