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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, NOVEMBER 1, 1936.

The report issued today covers stocks of meat, poultry and fish products in Canada by provinces, and by principal cities on November 1, 1936, with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at November 1, 1936, amounted to 35,759,381 pounds, of which 11,894,157 pounds were fresh frozen, 4,188,144 pounds fresh not frozen and 19,677,080 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings estimated to cover firms that failed to report amounted to 22,514 pounds making a grand total of 35,781,895 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of approximately 12.3 million pounds or 52.5 per cent over those reported at November 1 of the previous year, and an increase of 7.6 million pounds or 27 per cent as compared with the stocks shown at the first of the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at November 1, 1936, amounted to 2,303,054 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of 33,033 pounds for firms that failed to report, a grand total of 2,336,087 pounds is shown, which is approximately 105 thousand pounds or 4.3 per cent less than was reported at November 1, 1935, and 131 thousand pounds or 5.9 per cent more than the grand total shown at the first of the previous month.

Total beef stocks as reported amounted to 21,963,506 pounds, 14,245,485 pounds being fresh frozen, 7,108,810 pounds fresh not frozen, 343,474 pounds cured beef and 265,737 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 6,806 pounds, a grand total of 21,970,312 pounds is shown at November 1, 1936, an increase of approximately 2.3 million pounds or 12 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of the same month of 1935, and an increase of 5.4 million pounds or 32.7 per cent over the stocks of October 1, 1936.

Holdings of veal were reported at 5,288,717 pounds, 4,456,372 pounds being fresh frozen and 832,345 pounds being fresh not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 206 pounds amounted to 5,288,923 pounds an increase of 1.8 million pounds or 55.2 per cent compared with the quantity reported November 1, 1935 and approximately 690 thousand pounds or 15 per cent over the grand total at the first of the previous month.

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb stocks amounted to 5,644,085 pounds, 5,032,407 pounds of which were fresh frozen and 611,678 pounds fresh not frozen. With an estimate of 4,719 pounds to cover the holdings of firms which failed to report, a grand total of 5,648,804 pounds is shown. This represents an increase of 1.13 million pounds or 25.1 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of November, 1935, and an increase of 3.8 million pounds above the corresponding total for the first of October of this year.

Poultry stocks, as reported, amounted to 5,303,039 pounds. After adding 33,056 pounds for firms which failed to report, it shows a grand total of 5,336,095 pounds, which represents an increase of approximately 2.5 million pounds or 89.8 per cent over the quantity reported at the first of the same month of 1935 and an increase of 1.3 million pounds or 33.5 per cent as compared with the grand total shown at the first of the previous month.

Fresh and frozen fish reported at November 1, 1936, amounted to 25,893,065 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 373,746 pounds making a grand total of 26,266,811 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at November 1, of the previous year it shows an increase of approximately 349 thousand pounds or 1.3 per cent and compared with the holdings at the first of the previous month, an increase of approximately 1.6 million pounds or 6.6 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at November 1, amounted to 6,153,953 pounds which, combined with an estimate of 97,661 pounds, makes a grand total of 6,251,614 pounds. Making comparisons with stocks reported at November 1, 1935, these stocks represent an increase of 660.4 thousand pounds or 11.8 per cent, and compared with the grand total of October 1, of this year, a decrease of 74.2 thousand pounds or 1.2 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of October amounted to 6,628,357 pounds, representing an increase of 740.6 thousand pounds or 12.6 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of October, 1935, and an increase of 2.9 million pounds or 77.8 per cent in comparison with the quantities frozen during the month of ~~October~~, 1936.
