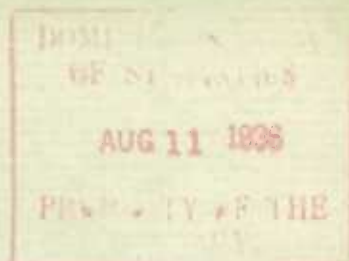

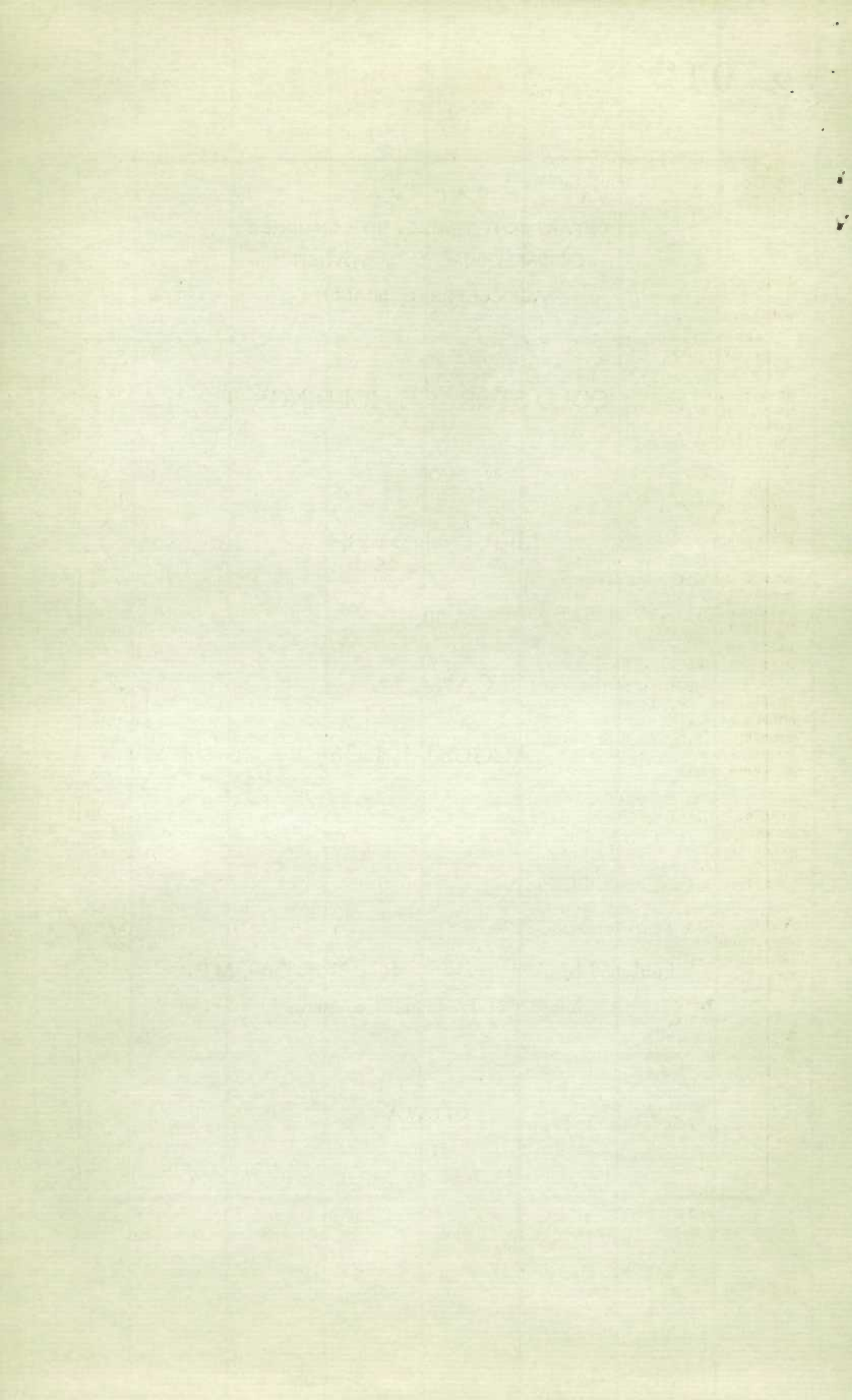

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, AUGUST 1, 1936.

The report issued today includes a record of meat, poultry and fish stocks in Canada by provinces and by the principal cities at August 1, 1936, with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at August 1, 1936 amounted to 29,524,401 pounds, of which 3,061,082 pounds were fresh, not frozen, 10,769,444 pounds frozen and 15,693,875 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings of firms that failed to report are estimated at 1,230,627 pounds, making a grand total of 30,755,028 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of 2½ million pounds or 10.1 per cent over those reported at August 1 of the previous year, and a decrease of approximately 7½ million pounds or 20.2 per cent from the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at August 1, 1936, amounted to 2,943,993 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of firms which failed to report, a grand total of 3,250,686 pounds is shown, which represents a decrease of approximately 755 thousand pounds or 20.4 per cent less than was reported at August 1, 1935, and 349 thousand pounds or 10.6 per cent less than the quantity shown by firms reporting at July 1, 1936.

Total beef stocks, as reported, amounted to 11,428,658 pounds, 5,502,713 pounds being fresh frozen, 4,939,750 pounds fresh, not frozen, 574,717 pounds cured beef and 411,478 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 278,871 pounds, a grand total of 11,707,529 pounds are shown at August 1, 1936, an increase of approximately 2½ million pounds or 29.7 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of the same month in 1935, but a decrease of over 1 million pounds or 10.6 per cent from the stocks shown at July 1, 1935.

Holdings of veal were reported at 3,618,979 pounds, 2,920,478 being fresh frozen and 698,501 pounds fresh, not frozen. The grand total, including estimated stocks of 61,109 pounds, amounted to 3,680,088 pounds, an increase of about 1½ million pounds or 65.8 per cent compared with the quantity reported at August 1, 1935, and ½ million pounds or 14.6 per cent compared with the stock reported at the first of the previous month.

The reported holdings of all classes of mutton and lamb amounted to 663,151 pounds, 431,864 pounds of which are frozen stocks and 231,287 pounds, not frozen. With an estimate of 8,284 pounds to cover the holdings of firms which failed to report, a grand total of 671,435 pounds is shown. This represents a decrease of approximately 237 thousand pounds or 26.4 per cent from the first of August 1935, and about 8 thousand pounds or 1.2 per cent from the first of July 1936.

Poultry stocks, as reported, amounted to 4,096,687 pounds. After adding 81,281 pounds for firms which failed to report it shows a grand total of 4,177,968 pounds which represents an increase of approximately 1 million pounds or 41.2 per cent over the same month of the previous year, but a decrease of 532 thousand pounds or 11.5 per cent from the first of July, 1936.

Fresh and frozen fish reported at August 1, 1936, amounted to 16,920,191 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 1,929,433 pounds making a grand total of 18,849,624 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at August 1 of the previous year it shows an increase of approximately 619 thousand pounds, or 3.8 per cent, and compared with the holdings of the previous month, an increase of 2½ million pounds or 17.3 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish were reported at August 1, 1936 as 5,071,745 pounds, which, combined with an estimate of 1,186,899 pounds makes a grand total of 6,258,644 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at August 1, 1935, these stocks represent an increase of 163 thousand pounds or 3.3 per cent, and compared with the holdings reported at July 1, 1936, an increase of approximately 123 thousand pounds or 2.5 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of July amounted to 4,882,710 pounds, representing a decrease of approximately 3½ million pounds from July 1935, and about 117 thousand pounds more than that reported during the month of June, 1936.

Estimated stocks represent the holdings of 24 firms that failed to report at August 1, 1936.
