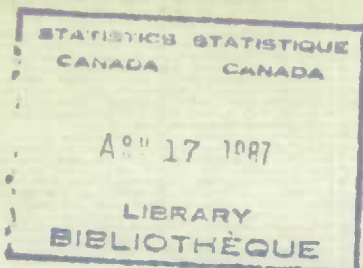

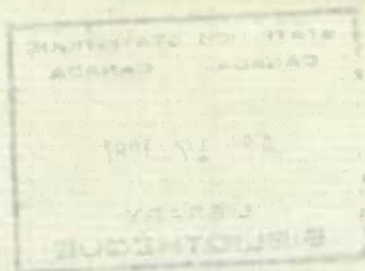

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, JANUARY 1, 1937.

The report issued to-day covers stocks of meat, poultry and fish products in Canada by provinces and by principal cities at January 1, 1937 with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at January 1, 1937 amounted to 44,932,733 pounds, of which 23,069,875 pounds were fresh frozen, 3,587,366 pounds fresh not frozen and 18,275,492 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings including an estimate to cover firms that failed to report amounted to 4,896,305 pounds, making a grand total of 49,829,038 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of approximately 19.5 million pounds or 64.3 per cent over those reported at January 1 of the previous year, and an increase of approximately 6.7 million pounds or 15.6 per cent as compared with the stocks shown at the first of the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at January 1, 1937 amounted to 2,133,114 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of 321,305 pounds for firms that failed to report, a grand total of 2,454,419 pounds is shown, which is almost 1 million pounds or 28.6 per cent less than was reported at January 1, 1936 and approximately 251.6 thousand pounds or 11.4 per cent more than was shown at the first of the previous month.

Total beef stocks as reported, amounted to 22,310,162 pounds, 17,239,418 pounds being fresh frozen, 4,519,427 pounds being fresh not frozen, 261,630 pounds cured beef and 289,687 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 1,446,921 pounds, a grand total of 23,757,083 pounds is shown at January 1, 1937, an increase of approximately 1.8 million pounds or 8.1 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of the same month of 1936 and a decrease of 2.2 million pounds or 8.6 per cent less than those shown at December 1, 1936.

Holdings of veal were reported at 4,174,731 pounds, 3,760,593 pounds being fresh frozen and 414,138 pounds being fresh not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 298,139 pounds amounted to 4,472,870 pounds, an increase of 1.6 million pounds or 56.4 per cent compared with the quantity reported at January 1, 1936 and approximately 579 thousand pounds or 11.5 per cent less than was reported at the first of the previous month.

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 6,940,421 pounds, 6,654,913 pounds of which were fresh frozen and 285,508 fresh not frozen. With an estimate of 293,856 pounds to cover the holdings of firms which failed to report, a grand total of 7,234,277 pounds is shown. This represents an increase of approximately 1.7 million pounds or 29.7 per cent over the stocks reported at the same date of the previous year and a decrease of 186 thousand pounds or 2.5 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of December, 1936.

Poultry stocks as reported amounted to 14,916,372 pounds. After adding 401,666 pounds for firms which failed to report it shows a grand total of 15,317,938 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 3.3 million pounds or 27.1 per cent over the quantity reported at the first of January, 1936, and an increase of 6.4 million pounds or 72.4 per cent as compared with the stocks shown at the first of the previous month.

Fresh frozen fish reported at January 1, 1937 amounted to 19,447,124 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 3,335,702 pounds, making a grand total of 22,782,826 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at January 1 of the previous year it shows an increase of approximately 1.2 million pounds or 5.8 per cent, and compared with the grand total at the first of the previous month a decrease of approximately 2.8 million pounds or 11 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at January 1, 1937 amounted to 5,487,352 pounds, which combined with an estimate of 587,274 pounds makes a grand total of 6,074,626 pounds. When comparisons are made with stocks reported at January 1, 1936, these figures represent an increase of over 1 million pounds or 23 per cent and compared with the stocks reported at December 1, 1936, a decrease of approximately 239 thousand pounds or 3.8 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of December, 1936 amounted to 2,483,319 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 507 thousand pounds or 25.6 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of December, 1935, and a decrease of approximately 740 thousand pounds or 23 per cent in comparison with the quantities frozen during the month of November, 1936.

The estimated stocks represent the holdings of 24 firms which failed to send in their statements in time for the figures to be included in this report.
