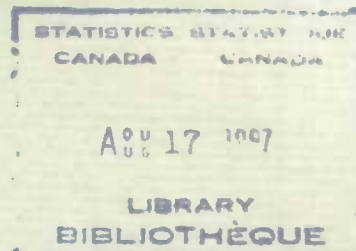

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, NOVEMBER 1, 1937.

This report is a summary of meat, fish and poultry stocks held in Cold Storage in Canada by provinces and principal cities as at November 1, 1937. For comparative purposes the figures of November 1, 1936 and October 1, 1937 are also shown.

PORK

Total pork stocks reported amounted to 26,123,299 lb. of which 4,992,005 lb. were fresh frozen, 4,205,264 lb., fresh not frozen and 16,926,080 lb. cured or in cure. Combining these figures with an estimate of 209,061 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 26,332,360 lb. is shown. This total is approximately 9.8 million lb. or 27.1 per cent less than that reported at November 1, 1936 and approximately 4.4 million lb. or 20.3 per cent greater than that reported at October 1, 1937.

LARD

Reported stocks of pure lard in storage amounted to 1,195,475 lb. On the addition of an estimate of 6,236 lb. for firms which failed to report, a grand total of 1,201,711 lb. is shown. This figure shows a decrease of approximately 1.2 million lb. or 49.2 per cent less than that reported at November 1, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 34 thousand lb. or 2.8 per cent less than that reported at the first of the previous month.

BEEF

The compilation of reported beef stocks shows a total of 25,607,098 lb. of which 16,901,141 lb. were fresh frozen, 8,073,852 lb. fresh not frozen, 446,356 lb. cured beef and 185,749 lb. in process of cure. Adding to this an estimate of 118,319 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 25,725,417 lb. is shown. Comparing these figures with those of November 1, 1936, there is an increase of approximately 3.5 million lb. or 16.0 per cent and with those of October 1, 1937, there is an increase of approximately 8.4 million lb. or 48.6 per cent.

VEAL

Veal holdings were reported at 4,353,665 lb. of which 3,413,176 lb. were fresh frozen and 940,489 lb. fresh not frozen. Adding to this an estimate of 15,041 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 4,368,706 lb. is shown. These figures show a decrease of approximately 947 thousand lb. or 17.8 per cent in comparison with those reported at November 1, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 8 thousand lb. or 0.2 per cent with those of October 1, 1937.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 3,424,837 lb. of which 2,801,191 lb. were fresh frozen and 623,646 lb. fresh not frozen. On the addition of an estimate of 11,939 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 3,436,776 lb. is shown. In comparison with November 1, 1936, a decrease of approximately 2.2 million lb. or 39.4 per cent is shown and with October 1, 1937, an increase of approximately 1.8 million lb. or 113.7 per cent is shown.

POULTRY

Reported stocks of poultry amounted to 3,794,619 lb. These figures represent a decrease of approximately 1.6 million lb. or 29.5 per cent less than those reported at November 1, 1936 and an increase of approximately 440 thousand lb. or 13.1 per cent over those reported at October 1, 1937.

FISH

Fresh frozen fish reported at November 1, 1937 amounted to 28,185,201 lb. added to which is an estimate of 2,636,441 lb. making a grand total of 30,821,642 lb. This total is approximately 4.2 million lb. or 15.8 per cent greater than that reported for the same month last year and approximately 3 million lb. or 10.6 per cent greater than that reported at October 1, 1937.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at November 1, 1937 amounted to 5,808,756 lb. Compared with stocks reported at November 1, 1936, a decrease of approximately 450 thousand lb. or 7.2 per cent is shown and compared with the total at the first of the previous month, there is a decrease of approximately 422 thousand lb. or 6.8 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of October, 1937 amounted to 7,021,450 lb. representing an increase of approximately 49 thousand lb. or 0.7 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of October 1936 and an increase of approximately 1.8 million lb. or 33.3 per cent in comparison with the quantity frozen during the month of September, 1937.
