

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, DECEMBER 1, 1937.

PORK

Total pork stocks reported amounted to 32,545,340 lb. of which 9,706,966 lb. were fresh frozen; 5,953,936 lb., fresh not frozen, and 16,884,438 lb. cured or in cure. Combining these figures with an estimate of 110,366 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 32,655,706 lb. is shown. This total is approximately 10.4 million lb. or 24.2 per cent less than that reported at December 1, 1936 and approximately 6.3 million lb. or 23.8 per cent greater than that reported at November 1, 1937.

LARD

Reported stocks of pure lard in storage amounted to 1,645,573 lb. This figure shows a decrease of approximately 550 thousand lb. or 25.3 per cent less than that reported at December 1, 1936 and an increase of approximately 438 thousand lb. or 36.3 per cent less than that reported at the first of the previous month.

BEEF

The compilation of <u>reported</u> beef stocks shows a total of <u>28,551,241</u> lb. of which 20,358,318 lb. were fresh frozen, 7,767,561 lb. fresh not frozen, <u>245,759</u> lb. cured beef and 179,603 lb. in process of cure. Adding to this an estimate of 74,133 lb. for firms failing to report, a <u>grand total</u> of <u>28,625,374</u> lb. is shown. Comparing these figures with those of December 1, 1936, there is an increase of approximately 2.6 million lb. or 10.2 per cent and with those of November 1, 1937, there is an increase of approximately 2.9 million lb. or 11.5 per cent.

VEAL

Veal holdings were reported at 4,143,482 lb. of which 3,343,669 lb. were fresh frozen and 799,813 lb. fresh not frozen. Adding to this an estimate of 19,902 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 4,163,384 lb. is shown. These figures show a decrease of approximately 900 thousand lb. or 17.6 per cent in comparison with those reported at December 1, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 200 thousand lb. or 4.3 per cent with those of November 1, 1937.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 5,034,124 lb. of which 4,535,696 lb. were fresh frozen and 498,428 lb. fresh not frozen. On the addition of an estimate of 8,656 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 5,042,780 lb. is shown. In comparison with December 1, 1936, a decrease of approximately 2.4 million lb. or 32.0 per cent is shown and with November 1, 1937, an increase of approximately 1.6 million lb. or 48.2 per cent is shown.

POULTRY


Reported stocks of poultry amounted to 6,142,787 lb. These figures represent a decrease of approximately 2.7 million lb. or 30.8 per cent less than those reported at December 1, 1936 and an increase of approximately 2.4 million lb. or 62.1 per cent over those reported at November 1, 1937.

FISH

Fresh frozen fish reported at December 1, 1937 amounted to 27,020,085 lb. added to which is an estimate of 2,416,667 lb. making a grand total of 29,436,752 lb. This total is approximately 3.9 million lb. or 15.3 per cent greater than that reported for the same month last year and approximately 936 thousand lb. or 3.1 per cent less than that reported at November 1, 1937.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish <u>reported</u> at December 1, 1937 amounted to 5,507,682 lb. Combining this figure with an estimate of 141,410 lb. for firms failing to report, a <u>grand total</u> of 5,649,092 lb. is shown. Compared with stocks reported at December 1, 1936, a decrease of approximately 683 thousand lb. or 10.8 per cent is shown and compared with the total at the first of the previous month, there is a decrease of approximately 184 thousand lb. or 3.2 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of November, 1937 amounted to 4,619,883 lb. representing an increase of approximately 1.4 million lb. or 43.3 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of November 1936 and a decrease of approximately 2.4 million lb. or 34.8 per cent in comparison with the quantity frozen during the month of October, 1937.



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
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
