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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, FEBRUARY 1, 1937.

The report issued to-day covers stocks of meat, poultry and fish products in Canada by provinces and by principal cities at February 1, 1937 with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at February 1, 1937 amounted to 51,386,356 pounds, of which 27,166,251 pounds were fresh frozen, 3,890,171 pounds fresh not frozen and 20,329,934 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings including an estimate of 22,954 pounds to cover firms that failed to report, amounted to 51,407,310 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of approximately 18.3 million pounds or 55.5 per cent over those reported at February 1 of the previous year, and an increase of approximately 1.8 million pounds or 3.6 per cent as compared with the stocks shown at the first of the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at February 1, 1937 amounted to 2,198,249 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of 11,250 pounds for firms that failed to report, a grand total of 2,209,499 pounds is shown, which is almost 1.5 million pounds or 39.8 per cent less than was reported at February 1, 1936 and approximately 123 thousand pounds or 5.3 per cent less than was shown at the first of the previous month.

Total beef stocks as reported, amounted to 20,441,486 pounds, 13,848,148 pounds being fresh frozen, 6,051,217 pounds being fresh not frozen, 281,798 pounds cured beef and 260,323 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 8,823 pounds, a grand total of 20,450,309 pounds is shown at February 1, 1937, an increase of approximately 140 thousand pounds over the stocks reported at the first of the same month of 1936 and a decrease of 3.5 million pounds or 14.6 per cent less than those shown at January 1, 1937.

Holdings of veal were reported at 3,294,799 pounds, 2,859,023 pounds being fresh frozen and 435,776 pounds being fresh not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 935 pounds amounted to 3,295,734 pounds, an increase of slightly more than 1 million pounds or 50.6 per cent compared with the quantity reported at February 1, 1936 and approximately 1.2 million pounds or 26.5 per cent less than was reported at the first of the previous month.

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 6,162,710 pounds, 5,917,005 pounds of which were fresh frozen and 245,705 fresh not frozen. With an estimate of 2,330 pounds to cover the holdings of firms which failed to report, a grand total of 6,165,040 pounds is shown. This represents an increase of approximately 1.4 million pounds or 29.0 per cent over the stocks reported at the same date of the previous year and a decrease of 1 million pounds or 14.3 per cent over the stocks reported at the first of January, 1937.

Poultry stocks as reported amounted to 14,241,667 pounds. After adding 132,260 pounds for firms which failed to report it shows a grand total of 14,373,927 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 3.2 million pounds or 29.0 per cent over the quantity reported at the first of February, 1936 and a decrease of 2.4 million pounds or 14.6 per cent as compared with the grand total shown at the first of the previous month.

Fresh frozen fish reported at February 1, 1937 amounted to 18,068,274 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 140,408 pounds, making a grand total of 18,208,682 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at February 1 of the previous year it shows an increase of approximately 1.3 million pounds or 7.8 per cent, and compared with the total at the first of the previous month a decrease of over 4 million pounds or 18.5 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at February 1, 1937 amounted to 4,923,351 pounds, which combined with an estimate of 10,963 pounds makes a grand total of 4,934,314 pounds. When comparisons are made with stocks reported at February 1, 1936, these figures represent an increase of nearly 1 million pounds or 24 per cent and compared with the stocks reported at January 1, 1937, a decrease of approximately 929 thousand pounds or 15.8 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of January, 1937 amounted to 2,122,516 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 297 thousand pounds or 16.3 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of January, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 391 thousand pounds or 15.6 per cent in comparison with the quantities frozen during the month of December, 1936.

Out of a total of 194 reporting firms, 10 failed to send in their returns in time for the figures to be included in this statement.

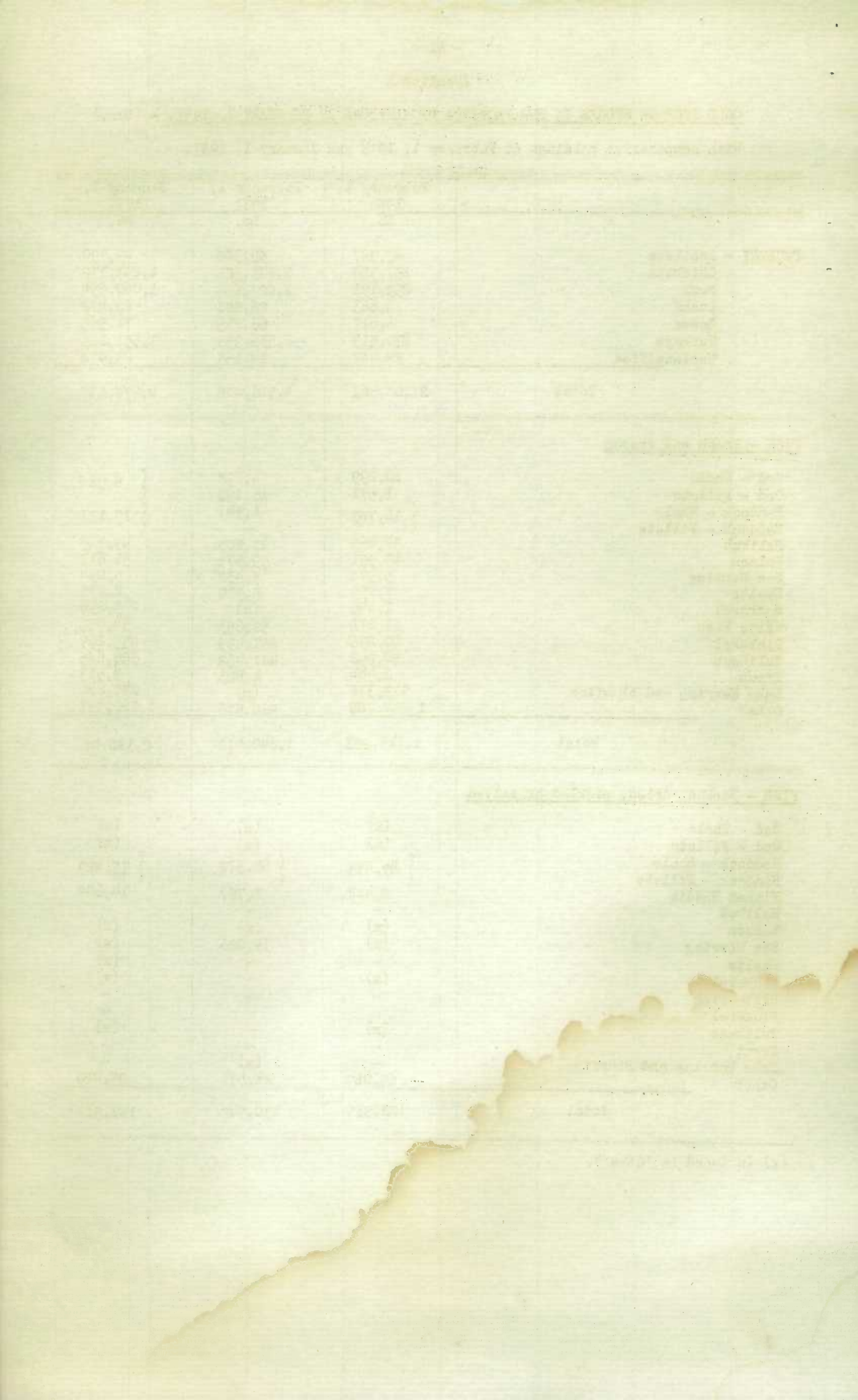
