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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, MARCH 1, 1937.

The report issued to-day covers stocks of meat, poultry and fish products in Canada by provinces and by principal cities at March 1, 1937 with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at March 1, 1937 amounted to 54,980,875 pounds, of which 29,152,645 pounds were fresh frozen, 4,332,278 pounds fresh not frozen and 21,495,952 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings including an estimate of 26,184 pounds to cover firms that failed to report, amounted to 55,007,059 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of approximately 19.3 million pounds or 54.2 per cent over those reported at March 1 of the previous year, and an increase of approximately 3.2 million pounds or 6.2 per cent as compared with the stocks shown at the first of the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at March 1, 1937 amounted to 2,416,007 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of 2,193 pounds for firms that failed to report, a grand total of 2,418,200 pounds is shown, which is almost 352 thousand pounds or 12.7 per cent less than was reported at March 1, 1936 and approximately 212 thousand pounds or 9.6 per cent more than was shown at the first of the previous month.

Total beef stocks as reported, amounted to 17,910,450 pounds, 12,411,151 pounds being fresh frozen, 4,822,886 pounds being fresh not frozen, 522,678 pounds cured beef and 153,735 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 7,806 pounds, a grand total of 17,918,256 pounds is shown at March 1, 1937, an increase of approximately 957 thousand pounds over the stocks reported at the first of the same month of 1936 and a decrease of 2.5 million pounds or 12.6 per cent less than those shown at February 1, 1937.

Holdings of veal were reported at 2,330,292 pounds, 1,937,525 pounds being fresh frozen and 392,767 pounds being fresh not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 89 pounds amounted to 2,330,381 pounds, an increase of approximately 697 thousand pounds or 42.6 per cent compared with the quantity reported at March 1, 1936 and approximately 974 thousand pounds or 29.5 per cent less than was reported at the first of the previous month.

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 5,410,653 pounds, 5,273,564 pounds of which were fresh frozen and 137,089 fresh not frozen. This represents an increase of approximately 1.8 million pounds or 49.4 per cent over the stocks reported at the same date of the previous year and a decrease of approximately 754 thousand or 12.2 per cent less than the stocks reported at the first of February, 1937.

Poultry stocks as reported amounted to 13,905,994 pounds. After adding 22,344 pounds for firms which failed to report it shows a grand total of 13,928,338 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 3.9 million pounds or 39.5 per cent over the quantity reported at the first of March, 1936 and a decrease of 1.8 million pounds or 11.3 per cent as compared with the total shown at the first of the previous month.

Fresh frozen fish reported at March 1, 1937 amounted to 14,035,974 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 9,993 pounds, making a grand total of 14,045,967 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at March 1 of the previous year it shows an increase of approximately 1 million pounds or 7.7 per cent, and compared with the total at the first of the previous month a decrease of about 4 million pounds or 22.5 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at March 1, 1937 amounted to 4,076,670 pounds, which combined with an estimate of 7,994 pounds makes a grand total of 4,084,664 pounds. When comparisons are made with stocks reported at March 1, 1936, these figures represent an increase of about 890 thousand pounds or 27.8 per cent and compared with the grand total reported at February 1, 1937, a decrease of approximately 856 thousand pounds or 17.3 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of February, 1937 amounted to 1,674,285 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 465 thousand pounds or 38.4 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of February, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 448 thousand pounds or 21.1 per cent in comparison with the quantities frozen during the month of January, 1937.

Out of a total of 194 reporting firms, 11 failed to send in their returns in time for the figures to be included in this statement.
