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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, JUNE 1, 1937.

The report issued to-day covers stocks of meat, poultry and fish products in Canada by provinces and by principal cities at June 1, 1937 with comparative holdings at the first of the previous month and at the first of the same month of the previous year.

Pork stocks reported at June 1, 1937 amounted to 51,265,381 pounds, of which 27,955,377 pounds were fresh frozen, 3,736,495 pounds fresh not frozen and 19,573,509 pounds cured or in cure. The total pork holdings including an estimate of 33,845 pounds to cover firms that failed to report, amounted to 51,299,226 pounds. These stocks represent an increase of approximately 13.3 million pounds or 34.9 per cent more than those reported at June 1 of the previous year, and a decrease of approximately 6.8 million pounds or 11.4 per cent as compared with the stocks shown at the first of the previous month.

Pure lard reported in storage at June 1, 1937 amounted to 2,606,120 pounds. Adding the estimated stocks of 6,955 pounds for firms that failed to report, a grand total of 2,613,075 pounds is shown, which is approximately 1.1 million pounds or 30.9 per cent less than was reported at June 1, 1936 and approximately 340 thousand pounds or 11.5 per cent less than was shown at the first of the previous month.

Total beef stocks as reported, amounted to 11,473,425 pounds, 5,695,779 pounds being fresh frozen, 5,438,079 pounds being fresh not frozen, 161,477 pounds cured beef and 178,090 pounds in process of cure. Including an estimate of 42,147 pounds, a grand total of 11,515,572 pounds is shown at June 1, 1937, a decrease of approximately 2.3 million pounds from the stocks reported at the first of the same month of 1936 and a decrease of 2.5 million pounds or 17.8 per cent less than those shown at May 1, 1937.

Holdings of veal were reported at 2,647,891 pounds, 1,821,423 pounds being fresh frozen and 826,468 pounds being fresh not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 2,248 pounds amounted to 2,650,139 pounds, an increase of approximately 90 thousand pounds or 3.5 per cent compared with the quantity reported at June 1, 1936 and approximately 540 thousand pounds or 25.9 per cent more than was reported at the first of the previous month.

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 1,895,800 pounds, 1,757,847 pounds of which were fresh frozen and 137,953 fresh not frozen. The grand total including estimated stocks of 5,033 pounds amounted to 1,900,833 pounds, an increase of approximately 1.1 million pounds or 149.7 per cent over the stocks reported at the same date of the previous year and a decrease of approximately 1.3 million pounds or 41.5 per cent less than the stocks reported at the first of May, 1937.

Poultry stocks as reported amounted to 6,859,618 pounds. After adding 10,404 pounds estimated for firms failing to report, there is a grand total of 6,870,022 pounds, representing an increase of approximately 1.4 million or 26.5 per cent over the quantity reported at the same date last year and a decrease of 1.3 million pounds or 15.7 per cent less than the figures for the previous month.

Fresh frozen fish reported at June 1, 1937 amounted to 14,049,230 pounds, added to which is an estimate of 165,706 pounds, making a grand total of 14,214,936 pounds. Compared with the stocks reported at June 1 of the previous year it shows an increase of approximately 3.2 million pounds or 29 per cent, and compared with the total at the first of the previous month, an increase of about 700 thousand pounds or 4.9 per cent.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at June 1, 1937 amounted to 4,389,877 pounds, which combined with an estimate of 9,165 pounds makes a grand total of 4,399,042 pounds. When comparisons are made with stocks reported at June 1, 1936, these figures represent a decrease of about 360 thousand pounds or 7.5 per cent and compared with the total reported at May 1, 1937, an increase of approximately 260 thousand pounds or 6.2 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of May, 1937 amounted to 2,621,116 pounds, representing a decrease of approximately 112 thousand pounds or 4.1 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of May, 1936 and an increase of approximately 450 thousand pounds or 20.6 per cent in comparison with the quantities frozen during the month of April, 1937.

Out of a total of 195 firms 10 failed to send in their returns in time for the figures to be included in this statement.
