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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, SEPTEMBER 1, 1937.

This report is a summary of meat, fish and poultry stocks held in Cold Storage in Canada by provinces and principal cities as at September 1, 1937. For comparative purposes the figures of September 1, 1936 and August 1, 1937 are also shown.

PORK

Total pork stocks reported amounted to 25,447,330 lb. of which 7,474,033 lb. were fresh frozen, 2,254,198 lb., fresh not frozen and 15,719,099 lb. cured or in cure. Combining these figures with an estimate of 25,143 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 25,472,473 lb. is shown. This total is approximately 2.3 million lb. or 8.3 per cent less than those reported at September 1, 1936 and approximately 9.6 million lb. or 27.4 per cent less than those reported at August 1, 1937.

LARD

Reported stocks of pure lard in Storage amounted to 1,747,566 lb. On the addition of an estimate of 1,602 lb. for firms which failed to report, a grand total of 1,749,168 lb. is shown. This figure shows a decrease of approximately 560 thousand lb. or 24.2 per cent under those reported at September 1, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 800 thousand lb. or 32.1 per cent under those reported at the first of the previous month.

BEEF

The compilation of reported beef stocks shows a total of 11,986,552 lb. 5,442,437 lb. being fresh frozen, 6,014,314 lb. fresh not frozen, 245,482 lb. cured beef and 284,319 lb. in process of cure. Adding to this an estimate of 19,843 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 12,006,395 lb. is shown. Comparing these figures with those of September 1, 1936, there is a decrease of approximately 750 thousand lb. or 5.9 per cent and with those of August 1, 1937, there is an increase of approximately 2.4 million lb. or 25.7 per cent.

VEAL

Veal holdings were reported at 3,460,845 lb. 2,401,697 lb. being fresh frozen and 1,059,148 lb. being fresh not frozen. These figures show a decrease of approximately 360 thousand lb. or 9.3 per cent in comparison with those reported at September 1, 1936 and an increase of approximately 380 thousand lb. or 12.3 per cent with those of August 1, 1937.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 776,724 lb. 470,768 lb. of which were fresh frozen and 305,956 lb. fresh not frozen. In comparison with September 1, 1936 an increase of approximately 10 thousand lb. or 1.3 per cent is shown and with those of August 1, 1937 an increase of approximately 104 thousand lb. or 15.5 per cent is shown.

POULTRY

Reported stocks of poultry amounted to 3,963,135 lb. which combined with an estimate of 11,597 lb. shows a grand total of 3,974,732 lb. These figures represent an increase of approximately 280 thousand lb. or 7.5 per cent over those reported at September 1, 1936 and a decrease of approximately 1.3 million lb. or 25.2 per cent under those reported at August 1, 1937.

FISH

Fresh frozen fish reported at September 1, 1937 amounted to 24,670,637 lb. added to which is an estimate of 531,492 lb. making a grand total of 25,202,129 lb. This total is approximately 1.5 million lb. or 6.6 per cent greater than those reported for the same month last year and approximately 3.6 million lb. or 17.0 per cent greater than those reported at August 1, 1937.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at September 1, 1937 amounted to 6,552,853 lb. which combined with an estimate of 82,260 lb. makes a grand total of 6,635,113 lb. Compared with stocks reported at September 1, 1936 an increase of approximately 20 thousand lb. or 0.3 per cent is shown and compared with the total at the first of the previous month, there is an increase of approximately 800 thousand lb. or 13.7 per cent.

Fish frozen during the month of August, 1937 amounted to 7,142,716 lb. representing an increase of approximately 1.1 million lb. or 18.5 per cent as compared with the quantity frozen during the month of August, 1936 and an increase of approximately 400 thousand lb. or 6.5 per cent in comparison with the quantity frozen during the month of July, 1937.

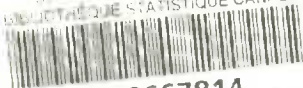
