



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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND FISH, SEPTEMBER 1, 1938.

Total storage stocks of meat on September 1, 1938 were 34,644,114 lb. compared with 41,720,062 lb. on the same date last year and 42,868,418 lb. at the first of the previous month.

PORK

Total pork stocks reported amounted to 19,600,223 lb. of which 2,783,121 lb. were fresh, 4,624,156 lb. frozen and 12,192,946 lb. cured or in cure. The grand total is 27.3 per cent less than last month and there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 7.4 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 9.7 million lb. during August 1937.

LARD

Total lard stocks amounted to 3,069,835 lb. There was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 500 thousand lb., while last year there was a similar movement of 830 thousand lb.

BEEF

The compilation of reported beef stocks shows a total of 8,953,778 lb. of which 5,750,955 lb. were fresh, 2,870,811 lb. frozen and 332,012 lb. cured or in cure. Combining this figure with an estimate of 289,000 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 9,242,778 lb. is shown. The "Out-of-Storage" movement during August 1938 was 436 thousand lb. Last year the movement was "Into-Storage" being 2.5 million lb. The grand total stocks this month are 4.5 per cent less than last month.

VEAL

Veal holdings were reported at 3,427,340 lb. of which 871,029 lb. were fresh and 2,556,311 lb. frozen. Adding to this an estimate of 6,500 lb. for firms failing to report, there is a grand total of 3,433,840 lb. This total is 7.0 per cent greater than last month and there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 225 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 373 thousand lb. during August 1937.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings of mutton and lamb amounted to 646,494 lb. of which 336,717 lb. were fresh and 309,777 lb. were frozen. Adding to this an estimate of 7,600 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 654,094 lb. is shown. The "Out-of-Storage" movement during August 1938 was 14 thousand lb. Last year the movement was "Into-Storage" being 104 thousand lb. The grand total stocks are 2.1 per cent less than last month.

POULTRY


Reported stocks of poultry amounted to 2,920,593 lb. An "Out-of-Storage" movement of 301 thousand lb. is noted while during August 1937, a similar movement of 1.1 million lb. occurred.

FISH

Fresh and frozen fish reported at September 1, 1938 amounted to 28,678,263 lb. Combining this figure with an estimate of 57,640 lb. for firms failing to report, a grand total of 28,735,903 lb. is shown. This total is approximately 3.6 million lb. greater than that reported on the same date last year and 11.3 per cent greater than that reported at August 1, 1938.

Stocks of smoked, dried, pickled and salted fish reported at September 1, 1938 amounted to 7,966,059 lb. This figure is 24.4 per cent greater than August 1, 1938 and 1.4 million lb. less than September 1, 1937.

Fish frozen during August 1938 amounted to 6,044,024 lb., being approximately 1.3 million lb. less than last year and 32.3 per cent less than July 1938.









COLD STORAGE STOCKS AT SEPTEMBER 1, 1938 - QUEBEC


