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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JANUARY 1, 1939.

It will be noticed that this report is somewhat different from that of last year. It has been considered necessary to publish meat and lard, and fish in separate volumes and to confine poultry to the report entitled "Stocks of Dairy and Poultry Products". As a result, this volume is based solely on Meat and Lard holdings at January 1, 1939.

A complete review of all storage stocks of meat shows that on January 1, 1939, there were 52,641,282 lb. This amount compared unfavourably with the stocks reported on the same day last year when there were 71,045,733 lb. but was very similar to the stocks at the first of the previous month when there were 56,606,633 lb.

PORK

Pork holdings at January 1, 1939 are reported as 25,040,736 lb. This total is divided into three classes, as follows:-

Fresh 2,084,078 lb; Frozen 10,658,574 lb., and Cured and In Cure 12,298,084 lb.

Combining the reported total with an estimate of 1,618,500 lb., for firms failing to report, a grand total of 26,659,236 lb., is shown. In comparison with the stocks at the first of the previous month, it is found that there is an increase of 7.2 per cent caused by a net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.8 million lb., Last year there was a similar movement of 4.6 million lb.

LARD

Firms reporting lard turned in figures totalling 2,471,745 lb. In comparison with the stocks at the first of the previous month, a net "Into-Storage" movement of 800 thousand lb., is noted, while last year there was a similar movement of 640 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reports of beef stocks record a total of 18,527,226 lb., of which 4,875,002 lb., were Fresh; 11,289,718 lb., Frozen; 386,177 lb., Cured and in Cure and 1,976,329 lb., Fancy Meats. Combining this total with an estimate of 706,400 lb., for firms failing to report, a grand total of 19,233,626 lb., is shown. Comparing this figure with that of December 1, 1938, it is found that there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.9 million lb.. During the same period last year, the net movement was also "Out-of-Storage" at 3.4 million lb. The grand total stocks this month are 8.9 per cent less than last month.

VEAL

Holdings of veal were reported at 4,063,056 lb., of which 381,484 lb., were Fresh; 3,433,017 lb., were Frozen, and 248,555 lb., Fancy Meats. Adding to this an estimate of 28,000 lb., for firms failing to report in time, a grand total of 4,091,056 lb., is shown. Comparatively, this figure shows a decrease with that of December 1, 1938, there having been a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1 million lb., while last year the net movement was also "Out-of-Storage" at 956 thousand lb. The grand total stocks this month are 20.1 per cent less than last month.

MUTTON and LAMB

Storage of mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 5,010,264 lb., of which 282,255 lb., were Fresh; 4,611,296 lb., were Frozen and 116,713 lb, Fancy Meats. On the addition of an estimate of 86,300 lb., for firms failing to report on time, a grand total of 5,096,564 lb., is shown. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement during December amounted to 400 thousand lb. The grand total stocks this month are 7.3 per cent less than last month.
