





COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, DECEMBER 1, 1939

ALL MEAT.

Storage stocks of all meat on December 1, 1939 were 86,394,920 lb. This total shows an increase of 29.8 million lb. as compared with the total on hand a year ago and during the past month there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 10.2 million lb.

FORK

Pork holdings of all varieties amounted to 46,587,839 lb. This total is divided into three classifications as follows: Fresh 5,987,016 lb.; Frozen 16,728,404 lb. and Cured and In Cure 23,872,419 lb. An estimate of 600,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brought the Grand Total to 47,187,839 lb. In comparison with the stocks at November 1, 1939, an increase is noted, representing a net "Into-Storage" movement of 7.5 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 408 thousand 1b.

LARD

The reported holdings of lard amounted to 2,907,589 lb. Adding to this an estimate of 83,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time a Grand Total of 2,990,589 lb. was shown. During November, there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 457 thousand lb. while last year there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 105 19.109,407 thousand 1b.

BEEF


Storage holdings of beef were reported as 28,499,953 lb. of which 7,891,138 15. were Fresh; 17,663,558 lb. were Frozen; 394,744 lb. were Cured and In Cure and 2,750,493 lb. were Fancy Meats. Combining the reported total with an estimate of 466,000 lb. for late firms, there was a Grand Total of 28,965,953 lb.

There was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 3.2 million lb. during November while for the same period a year ago there was a similar movement of 3.7 million lb. The Grand Total stocks this month were 12.5 per cent greater than last month.

Veal storage showed reports totalling 4,847,674 lb. of which 665,707 lb. were Fresh: 3,860,944 lb. were Frozen and 321,023 lb. were Fancy Meats. On the addition of an estimate of 43,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, the Grand Total is brought to 4,890,674 lb. A net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 107 thousand 1b. during November was noted while last year there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 246 thousand lb. The Grand Total stocks this month were 2,2 per cent less than last month.


MUTTON AND LAMB

Storage of mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 6,459,454 lb. of which 368,571 lb. were Fresh; 5,901,109 lb. were Frozen and 189,774 lb. were Fancy Meats. Combining the reported total with an estimate of 21,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time there was a Grand Total of 6,480,454 lb. A net "Into-Storage" movement during November amounted to 743 thousand lb. while last year a similar movement amounted to 931 thousand 1b. The Grand Total stocks this month were 12,9 per cent greater than last month.




