

### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, FEBRUARY 1, 1939.

Storage stocks of all meat on February 1, 1939 were 55,598,460 lb. There was a large decrease as compared with the stocks reported on the same day last year when there were 72,983,312 lb. but only a slight increase over the stocks at the first of last month when there were 55,568,704 lb.

### PORK

Pork holdings at February 1, 1939 are shown as <u>29,020,135</u> lb. This total is divided into three classes, as follows:-Fresh 4,089,419 lb.; Frozen 11,398,981 lb., and Cured and In Cure 13,531,735 lb. In comparison with the stocks at the first of the previous month, there is an increase of 7.9 per cent being a net "Into-Storage" movement of 2.1 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 3.7 million lb.

### LARD

Firms reporting lard gave figures totalling 2,094,551 lb. A net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 508 thousand lb., during January is noted while last year there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 163 thousand lb.

### BEEF

The reports of beef stocks record a total of <u>19,165,691</u> lb., of which 7,740,336 lb., were Fresh; 8,838,629 lb., Frozen; 399,914 lb., Cured and In Cure and 2,186,812 lb., Fancy Meats. There was a net "Into-Storage" movement of six thousand lb., while during the same period last year, the net movement was "Out-of-Storage" being 443 thousand lb.

### VEAL

Holdings of veal were reported at 3,068,799 lb., of which 595,334 lb., were Fresh; 2,329,627 lb., were Frozen, and 143,838 lb., Fancy Meats. Comparatively, this figure shows an increase over that of February 1, 1938 of 763 thousand lb. There was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1 million lb., while last year the net movement was also "Out-of-Storage" being 901 thousand lb. The grand total stocks this month are 25.3 per cent less than last month.

### MUTTON AND LAMB

Storages of mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 4,338,835 lb., of which 417,280 lb., were Fresh; 3,833,672 lb., were Frozen and 87,883 lb., Fancy Meats. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement during January amounted to 1.1 million lb., while last year the net movement was also "Out-of-Storage" being 453 thousand lb. The grand total stocks this month are 19.9 per cent less than last month.
