COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, MARCH 1, 1939.

Storage stocks of all meat on March 1, 1939 were 52,474,419 lb. There was a large decrease as compared with the stocks reported on the same day last year when there were 66,426,684 lb. and a small decrease as compared with the stocks at the first of last month when there were 55,764,162 lb.

PORK

Pork holdings at March 1, 1939 are shown as 31,280,617 lb. This total is divided into three classes, as follows:

Fresh 4,191,948 lb.; Frozen 12,092,359 lb., and Cured and In Cure 14,996,310 lb.

In comparison with the stocks at the first of the previous month, there is an increase of 7.7 per cent being a net "Into-Storage" movement of 2.2 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 503 thousand lb.

LARD

Firms reporting lard gave figures totalling 2,039,145 lb. A net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 58 thousand lb., during February is noted while last year there was a similar movement of 398 thousand lb.

BEEF

The reports of beef stocks record a total of 15,724,340 lb., of which 6,363,858 lb., were Fresh; 6,787,335 lb., Frozen; 370,172 lb., Cured and In Cure and 2,202,975 lb., Fancy Meats. There was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 3.6 million lb., while during the same period last year, the net movement was also "Out-of-Storage" being 5.3 million lb. The grand total stocks this month are 18.5 per cent less than those of last month.

VEAL

Holdings of veal were reported at 2,100,037 lb., of which 665,755 lb., were Fresh; 1,287,909 lb., were Frozen, and 146,373 lb., were Fancy Meats. Comparatively, this total figure shows an increase of 600 thousand lb., over that of March 1, 1938. There was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 984 thousand lb., while last year the net movement was also "Out-of-Storage" being 779 thousand lb. The grand total stocks this month are 31.9 per cent less than last month.

MUTTON AND LAMB

Storages of mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 3,369,425 lb., of which 264,356 lb., were Fresh; 3,018,441 lb., were Frozen and 86,628 lb., were Fancy Meats. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement during February amounted to 974 thousand lb., while last year a similar net movement amounted to 979 thousand lb. The grand total stocks this month are 22.4 per cent less than last month.
