COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, JUNE 1, 1939

ALL MEAT.

Storage stocks of all meats on June 1, 1939 were 53,735,438 lb.

There was a slight decrease as compared with the total reported on the same day last year when there were 56,213,075 lb., while in comparison with the previous month, a small increase is noted, the stocks at that date being 53,424,905 lb.

PORK.

Holdings of Pork at June 1, 1939 are shown as 35,778,601 lb.

This total is divided into three classes as follows: Fresh 4,332,894 lb.; Frozen 16,050,294 lb.; and Cured and In Cure 15,395,413 lb. Adding to the total an estimate of 138,000 lb., for firms failing to report on time, there is a Grand Total of 35,916,601 lb. In comparison with the stocks reported at the first of the previous month, there is a decrease of 0.8 per cent being a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 303 thousand lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 5.1 million lb.

LARD.

Firms reporting lard gave figures totalling 3,889,830 lb. Combining this figure with an estimate of 41,000 lb., for firms failing to

report in time, a Grand Total of 3,930,830 lb. is shown. A net "Into-Storage" movement of 821 thousand lb. during May is noted, while last year the net movement was "Out-of-Storage" at 243 thousand lb.

BEEF.

The reports of beef stocks record a total of 13,378,606 lb. of which 6,729,058 lb. were Fresh; 3,588,198 lb. were Frozen; 400,988 lb.

were Cured and In Cure and 2,660,362 lb. were Fancy Meats. An estimate of 99,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brings the Grand Total to 13,477,606 lb. There was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 703 thousand lb. while during the same period a year ago, there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.3 million lb. The Grand Total stocks this month are 5.5 per cent greater than last month.

VEAL.

Veal holdings were reported at 3,431,382 lb. of which 1,264,606 lb. were Fresh; 1,899,596 lb. were Frozen and 267,180 lb. were Fancy

Meats. There was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 912 thousand lb. while last year there was a similar movement of 822 thousand lb. The Grand Total stocks this month are 36.2 per cent greater than last month.

MUTTON AND LAMB

Storage of mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 1,146,849 lb. of which 191,229 lb. were Fresh; 889,929 lb. were Frozen and

65,691 lb. were Fancy Meats. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement during May amounted to 765 thousand lb. while last year a similar movement amounted to 886 thousand lb. The Grand Total stocks this month are 40.0 per cent less than last month.
