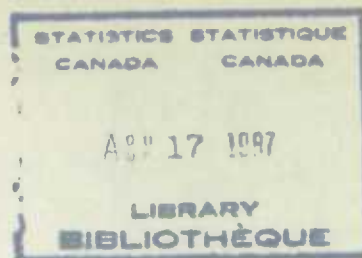

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, SEPTEMBER 1, 1939

ALL MEAT. Storage stocks of all meat on September 1, 1939 were 42,582,668 lb. In comparison with the stocks reported at the first of September 1938, there was an increase of 7.5 million lb. while with the first of last month there was a decrease of 12.6 per cent.

PORK. Pork holdings of all varieties amounted to 25,713,044 lb. This total is divided into three classifications as follows:

Fresh, 3,520,474 lb.; Frozen 6,378,770 lb. and Cured and In Cure 15,813,800 lb.

Combining the reported total with an estimate of 206,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, a Grand Total of 25,919,044 lb. is shown. In comparison with the previous month's stocks, a decrease of 15.4 per cent is noted, representing a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 4.7 million lb. Last year there was a similar movement of 7.4 million lb.

LARD. The reported holdings of lard amounted to 2,554,997 lb. An estimate of 87,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time brought the Grand Total to 2,641,997 lb. A net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.4 million lb. during August is noted, while last year there was a similar movement of 472 thousand lb.

BEEF. Storage holdings of beef were reported as 11,929,873 lb. of which 6,375,295 lb. were Fresh; 2,782,463 lb. were Frozen; 693,473 lb. were Cured and In Cure and 2,078,642 lb. were Fancy Meats. Combining the reported figure with an estimate of 81,000 lb. for late firms, a Grand Total of 12,010,873 lb. is shown. There was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.1 million lb. during August while for the same period a year ago, there was a similar movement of 688 thousand lb. The Grand Total stocks this month are 8.3 per cent less than last month.

VEAL. Veal storage showed reports of 4,019,913 lb. of which 770,116 lb. were Fresh; 2,935,533 lb. were Frozen and 314,264 lb. were Fancy Meats. On the addition of an estimate of 28,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there is a Grand Total of 4,047,913 lb. During August there was a net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 46 thousand lb. while last year there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 216 thousand lb. The Grand Total stocks this month are 1.1 per cent less than last month.

MUTTON AND LAMB. Storage of mutton and lamb showed a reported total of 919,838 lb. of which 399,633 lb. were Fresh; 423,852 lb. were Frozen and 96,353 lb. were Fancy Meats. An estimate of 21,000 lb. for late firms brought the Grand Total to 940,838 lb. The net "Into-Storage" movement during August amounted to 43 thousand lb. while last year a similar movement amounted to eight thousand lb. The Grand Total stocks this month are 4.7 per cent greater than last month.
