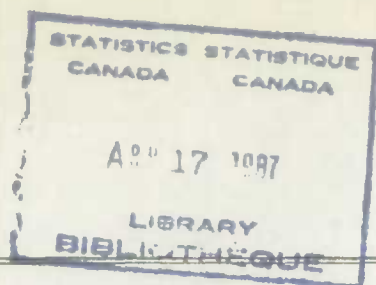

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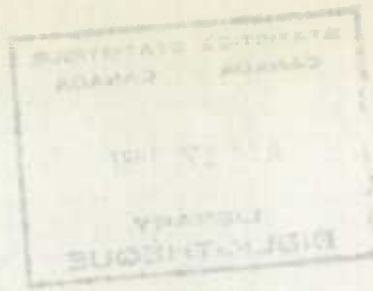

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD, OCTOBER 1, 1940

ALL MEAT

The Grand Total stocks of all Canadian and Imported meat were
58,280,763 lb.

The reported holdings of Canadian meat amounted to 55,837,669 lb. With an addition of 1,218,000 lb. estimated for firms failing to report on time, there was a total of 57,055,669 lb. There was an increase of 6.2 million lb. over the total Canadian meat stocks of a year ago, while during September 1940 there was a net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.7 million lb.

P O R K

The reported holdings of Canadian pork were 36,389,328 lb. consisting of Fresh 5,982,701 lb; Frozen 6,099,331 lb; and Cured 24,307,296 lb. There was also an estimate of 1,120,000 lb. for late firms, which brought the Grand Total of Canadian pork to 37,509,328 lb. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 276 thousand lb. as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 1.4 million lb. last year.

There were additional reported holdings of Imported pork amounting to 1,051,144 lb.

L A R D

The reported holdings amounted to 2,245,080 lb. which were 620 thousand lb. more than last year. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.7 million lb. Last year there was an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1 million lb.

B E E F

The stocks of Canadian beef were reported as 13,694,280 lb. These consisted of 7,652,487 lb. Fresh; 4,246,157 lb. Frozen; 267,536 lb. Cured; and 1,528,100 lb. Fancy Meats. With an estimate of 90,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time, there was a Grand Total of 13,784,280 lb. These stocks are 8.9 per cent. greater than last month and show an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 1.1 million lb. compared with a similar movement of 4.6 million lb. a year ago. The holdings this year are 2.8 million lb. less than last year.

In addition to the Canadian Stocks there were reports of Imported Beef totalling 83,000 lb.

V E A L

These stocks totalled 4,379,698 lb. as reported, being Fresh 897,543 lb; Frozen 3,113,567 lb; and Fancy Meats 368,588 lb. They are 12.2 per cent. greater than those of last month, there having been an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 478 thousand lb. during September 1940, while last year there was a similar movement of 503 thousand lb.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The holdings of Canadian as reported totalled 1,374,363 lb. consisting of Fresh 453,748 lb; Frozen 744,827 lb; and Fancy Meats 175,815 lb. The apparent net additions during September were 329,000 lb. as compared with a net "Into-Storage" movement of 1 million lb. during September 1939.

There were reported stocks in addition of Imported mutton and lamb amounting to 90,713 lb.
